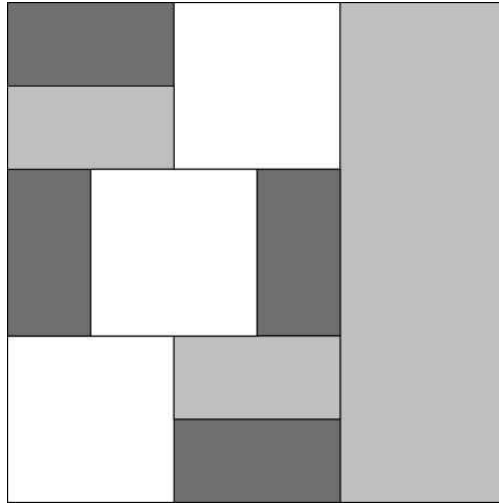


## Week 2

## #52blocks52weeks



White = light fabric  
Light grey = medium fabric  
Dark grey = dark fabric

**Makes a 6 ½" unfinished block**

### **Cutting:**

From light fabric  
three 2 ½" squares

From medium fabric  
one 2 ½" x 6 ½"  
two 2 ½" x 1 ½"

From dark fabric  
four 1 ½" x 2 ½"

### **Sewing:**

Sew two of the dark rectangles to opposite sides of one of the light squares.

Sew one dark rectangle to a medium rectangle along the 2 ½" side. Repeat.

Lay the blocks out following the diagram and sew into rows leaving the 2 ½" x 6 ½" medium fabric rectangle to sew last. Then sew rows into a block and then sew the medium rectangle on.
