Workshop Title: Level Two Tote (Finished size 15.5" wide x 13" high x 5.5" deep)

Date & Time: Saturday, June 15, 2019, 8:30am – 4 pm with a 90-minute lunch break

Location: EY Centre Hall 1

Kit Fee: \$35 – Please bring to class, correct change appreciated

Kit Includes:

8" metal tooth zipper

2 lengths leather strap, 30" long x 3/4" wide plus 4 scraps 1 1/2" long x 3/4" wide

1 magnetic snap

8 rivets in metal color to match zipper teeth & pull

Student Supplies:

Sewing machine*

Fabric and Notion Requirement:

1/2 yard Upper Level Fabric: Home Dec weight, cotton canvas, cotton linen blend

1/2 yard Lower Level Fabric (base of tote): waxed canvas, cork fabric, lightweight leather* or pleather

NOTE: if using upcycled leather or other substrate, you need a rectangle 17" wide x 16" high

1/2 yard Tote Lining: quilting cotton

1/4 yard contrast lining for zip pocket: quilting cotton or cotton linen blend

10" scrap contrast fabric for inside slip pocket: quilting cotton or cotton linen blend

1 yd fusible lightweight WOVEN interfacing (Pellon SF-101, also referred to as ShapeFlex)

Small scrap fusible fleece

Topstitch 90/14 machine needle

Coordinating polyester thread

Pencil or disappearing fabric pen

Sharp- tipped small scissors

Also useful: Wondertape©, Wonderclips©, flowerhead or other heavy duty pins, fabric glue and *leather machine sewing needles + heavy duty polyester thread if using leather for Lower Level Fabric.

All tools required to punch leather and set rivets will be provided by the instructor in class.
