Sewing machine*

¼" foot

All students will need to purchase the pattern - \$15

Tamara is offering to kit the fabric for those who are interested (cost: \$72). It will include all fabrics for the quilt top and binding – 6 yards in total). Orders for fabric kits must be placed with Tamara by May 15th, 2019.

For students bringing their own fabrics, the following are required:

- A rainbow of fabric colours: 26 fat eighths, 2 eighth yards (cut across the width of fabric for leaf stem)
- 2 yards of background fabric
- 1/2 yard binding fabric (not necessary to bring to class)
- 48" x 48" backing fabric (not necessary to bring to class)
- Batting: 52" x 52" (not necessary to bring to class).

Supplies:

- medium-grey thread
- fabric and paper scissors
- cutting mat
- rotary cutter
- acrylic ruler, (6" x 18" works well)
- 12" flat metal ruler
- fabric pins
- pencil
- glue stick
- tweezers
