

# Supply List for Quilt Canada 2019 Workshop

**Workshop Title:** Landscape Scarves with Machine Stitching

## **Your \$30 Kit will contain:**

1. Water soluble Fabric 2 weights: Each person will get 1 yard Sulky® Sticky Fabri Solvy and 1 yard Sulky® Solvy.
2. Sewing Threads
3. Hand Stitching Threads
4. A Variety of fabrics, ribbons etc.

## **In addition to your kit, you will need:**

**Sewing Machine\*:** One of the most challenging things about machine embroidery is working with the sewing machine. It can be frustrating, it can be tricky. So before the workshop starts, make sure that you are familiar with the sewing machine. Spend some time exploring the different stitches and make sure you know how to thread the machine, load the bobbin etc. This workshop will be about exploring stitching and experimenting with it so it is ideal to have a handle on the quirks and personality of your tools before coming into the workshop.

**Sewing Machine feet:** Free motion foot and clear foot

**Sewing machine needles** can break or get sticky with the special water-soluble fabrics we will be using - so bring some extras with you. I would recommend picking up Universal, Sharp or Machine Embroidery needles.

**Embroidery Hoop:** This should be a smaller hoop that is around 6-10 inches across. Anything slightly bigger or smaller, you are welcome to bring as well.

**Scissors:** Fabric scissors and/or Embroidery scissors and/or fun scissors

**Towel:** Bring an old towel with you to dry the samples.

**Pins:** These can be helpful for holding materials in place.

**Thread:** polyester, cotton or rayon threads (regular weight)

**Optional Supplies:**

Scrap fabrics: Bring materials that you love. I know I have bins of beautiful fabric I'm just saving- and you might too! Bring some of your beauties to integrate into your project. Small amounts of fabric are all that's needed for this project and smaller pieces (1"x1") will work well.

Scrap yarns: Do you have scraps from previous projects that you are saving? This technique is an excellent way to recycle some of these materials.

Sewing threads: These will be used for stitching your piece together. Bring in some threads that will fit with your colour scheme but also bring in some unexpected colours. These can be any weight and any fibre. I usually stitch with cotton or polyester.

Embroidery threads: This is optional. I will have a variety of threads for hand stitching.

Roving: This looks excellent with machine embroidery.

Extras: Anything that you would like to include like buttons, sequins, lace, trim, thin wire etc. are welcome.
