## **Basic sewing supplies:**

Machine\*

Free motion foot

Marking pen

snipping scissors

cutter and small cutting mat

ruler

## **Fabric and Thread:**

Finished size 8" x 12" landscape: Lone Pine

Sizing is approximate, you will not use the entire fabric, but this ensures you have enough

1/2 yd medium weight Fusible Iron on Tear Away Stabilizer e.g., Craft Fuse or Sulky Tear Away

1/4 yd Fusible web e.g., Wonder Under

1/4 yd blue for sky and water background. Can be hand dye, or solid. Can be 2 fabrics, one for sky and one for water.

2" strip for background islands. Dark grey, black or dark green solid  
2-3 3" strips beige, light grey or sand colour for islands, can be solid.  
Fabrics you may wish to trial for borders (if you are thinking of putting borders on)  
6"- 7" hoop. Low profile, friction fit or spring hoop – (light weight wooden hoops with the screw are not ideal – they tend to break under the tension)

2-3 8"x 8" squares of practice fabric, stabilizer and thread for sample stitching

Thread:

You can use embroidery weight or regular sewing threads 40wt-50wt in the top. I suggest black, grey or beige in the bobbin. The following are suggestions for a minimum, you may bring as much as you wish.

Black

3-4 shades of grey (light, medium, dark)

2 shades of brown (medium, dark)

1-2 shades of beige or sand

3-4 shades of green (avoid bright tones)

Min of 3-5 shades of blue. (Light to medium)
