Sewing machine*

Free motion foot

- Fresh 80/12 or 90/14 needles
- Glue stick (UHU or Elmer's etc.)
- Pencil and sharpener, or mechanical pencil
- Scissors (paper friendly, but sharp), both small and larger sizes, if possible
- Pins for basting
- Quilting gloves
- Water soluble or disappearing pen of your choice for both dark and light fabrics
- Small Ziploc bag

Optional:

- Close up map print-out of your favourite region, including significant roads/landmarks
- Tweezers

Fabric & Thread requirements:

- Solid fabrics:
 - » Deep blue: (1) 13" x 13", (1) 14" x 14"
 - » Pale green scrap: ~3" x 10"
 - » White (1) 13" x 13"
 - » Scrap of accent fabric, if desired
- Batting: 13½" x 13½"
- White thread
- Thread in accent colour (coordinating with accent fabric for heart above)
- Warm up quilt sandwich - 8" x 8" scrap fabric, batting and backing
