

#52blocks52weeks



Instructions:

Makes a 6 ½" unfinished block

White = light fabric

Light Grey = medium fabric

Dark Grey = dark fabric

Cutting

From light fabric:

One 2 ½" square

Four 1 ½" squares

From medium fabric:

Two 3" squares

Four 1 ½" squares

From dark fabric:

Two 3" squares

Eight 1 ½" squares

Sewing

Lay one medium and one dark 3" square RST (right sides together). Draw a line on the diagonal. Sew ¼" on either side of diagonal. Cut on drawn line. Open, press your two HST (half square triangles and trim to 2 ½". Repeat.

Right sides together, sew one 1 ½" dark square to one 1 ½" light square. Repeat 3 times to get a total of four dark/light rectangles.

Right sides together, sew one 1 ½" dark square to one 1 ½" medium square. Repeat 3 times to get a total of four dark/medium rectangles.

Right sides together, sew the dark/medium rectangle to the light/dark rectangle so that the dark squares are diagonal to each other, as pictured in the diagram.

Layout the blocks as pictured and sew the blocks into rows.

Sew the rows together.
