

'Juggle It All'

Instructions:

Makes a 6 ½" unfinished block

White = light fabric Light Grey = medium fabric Dark Grey = dark fabric


From light fabric 1 ½" x 7" Three 1 ½" x 4"


From medium fabric Two 1 ½" x 4" Four 1 ½" x 3 ½"

From dark fabric Two 1 ½" x 7" 1 ½" x 4"

Sewing

Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" medium fabric to either side of a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" light fabric along the 4" side. Cut to get two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " medium/light/medium units.







Sew a dark 1 ½" x 7" to either side of a light 1 ½" x 7". Cut to get four 1 ½" x 3 ½" dark/light/dark units.



Sew a light 1 ½" x 4" to either side of a dark 1 ½" x 4". Cut to get two 1 ½" x 3 ½" light/dark/light units.



Following the diagram, sew these units together to get two 3 ½" square units looking like a checkerboard.



Layout as pictured and sew each unit into rows, then sew the rows together.
