Ironing Station (Shared) - Iron and ironing pad

## **Student Supplies:**

Using needle-turn or Apliquick turned-edge appliqué, we will learn how to make the birth flower of your choice. Additional fabric will be required to complete the block but will not be needed in class.

- background fabric 18" x 18"

NOTE: If you cannot see through your background fabric for tracing, bring a light box or graphite paper, Transdoodle paper, or some other type of transfer paper to mark the fabric from the top.

- assorted appliqué fabrics (fat quarters or scraps): 5-6+ for flower, 3-5 for stem and leaves

For needle-turn appliqué: white freezer paper

For Apliquick method: Apliquick interfacing\*, glue stick\* and rods\*, foam core board (recommended for pinning prepared patches onto pattern)

- pencil\*
- fine cotton (50-weight or 60-weight) or silk threads to match appliqué fabrics
- appliqué needle\*
- appliqué pins\*
- removable fabric marking pens\* or pencils\* visible on all fabrics
- scissors for detailed cutting\*
- paper scissors, if desired
- sandpaper board (optional)
- light box (if you have one or if you cannot see through your background fabric for tracing)
- Ziploc bag to store cut-out shapes
