

'Oh My'

#52blocks52weeks



**Brought to you by the Canadian Quilters' Association (CQA/ACC) -
Promoting quilting in Canada, one block at a time.**

Instructions:

Makes a 6 ½" unfinished block

White = light fabric

Light grey = medium fabric

Dark grey = dark fabric

Cutting

From light fabric

Two 2 ½" x 3 ½"

Two 3 ½" squares

From medium fabric

Two 1 1/2" x 3 ½"

From dark fabric

Twelve 1 ½" squares

Sewing

On the back of each dark $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square, draw a line on the diagonal from one corner to the other.


Lay a dark square on one end of the medium strip, ensuring the drawn diagonal line on square starts at top left and goes to bottom right (as shown in the picture) and sew ON the line. Fold back and press. Trim excess fabric ($\frac{1}{4}$ " from sewn line). Repeat for other medium strip.



With the light $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " piece, put a dark square at the top right and bottom right using the diagram to see diagonal drawn line placement. Sew on the line. Fold back and press. Trim excess fabric ($\frac{1}{4}$ " from sewn line) and repeat for other light $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".



With the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square, put a square at each top corner and bottom right corner using the diagram to see diagonal drawn line placement. Sew on the line. Fold back and press. Trim excess fabric ($\frac{1}{4}$ " from sewn line) and repeat for other $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



Arrange the units as per the diagram and sew into rows, then sew the rows together.

CQA/ACC TIP: Did you know that it is so much fun to enter the National Juried Show? Your quilt, if chosen, gets to hang at Quilt Canada! A jury of 3 certified or apprentice judges will look through all the submissions and select those to hang. Once your quilt has been juried in, you send it to the Jury Coordinator who then arranges for the 3 judges to judge it at the show before Quilt Canada opens. The winners receive cash prizes and a big CQA/ACC ribbon! If you have never entered, consider it. The categories are so inclusive and the whole process is positive, even if you don't get in the first time, the thrill of entering is second to none. And when you do get in... well, there is nothing like it!
