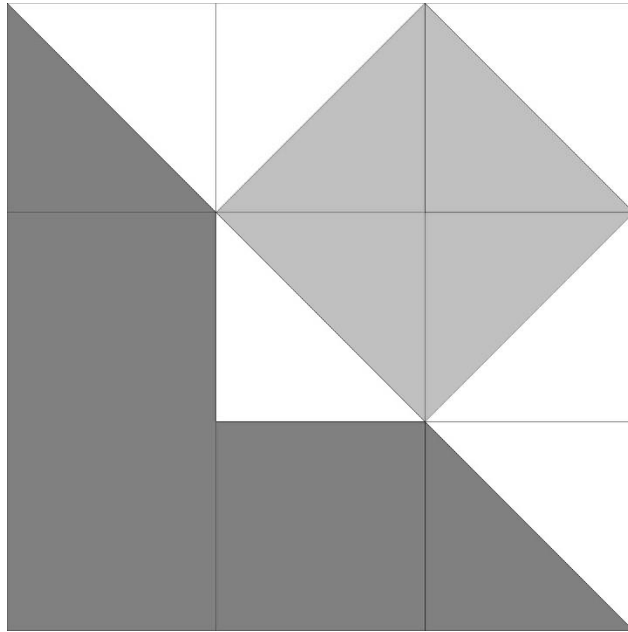


Week 51

'Tipping'

#52blocks52weeks

Instructions:

Makes a 6 ½" unfinished block

White = light fabric

Light grey = medium fabric

Dark grey = dark fabric

Cutting

From light fabric

Three 3" squares

From medium fabric

Two 3" squares

From dark fabric

2½" square

3" square

2 ½" x 4 ½"

Sewing

Lay one light and one medium 3" square right sides together. Draw a line on the diagonal. Sew ¼" on either side of diagonal. Cut on drawn line. Open, press your two half square triangles and trim to 2 ½". Repeat.

Lay one light and one dark 3" square right sides together. Draw a line on the diagonal. Sew ¼" on either side of diagonal. Cut on drawn line. Open, press your two half square triangles and trim to 2 ½".

Following the diagram, sew a dark/light half square triangle to the top of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" dark rectangle.

Lay out as pictured and sew the light medium half square triangles together. Sew the 2 ½" dark square to the remaining dark/light half square triangle. Sew this new unit to the bottom of the medium/light unit.

Sew to the last unit.
