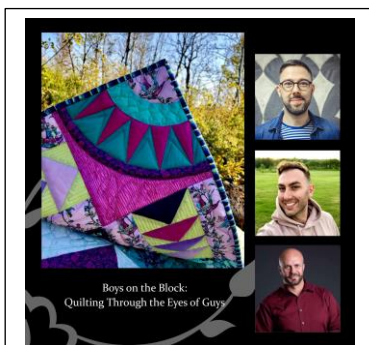

- Do you need to add or change an item? The most important thing here is speed soon as you know please call or email.
- Do you have a time conflict in your schedule? Janet can help with this.
- Did you receive your emailed Entry Pass and confirmation from the online registration form? Please save them on your device as well as print them.
- **This year your workshop registration will also allow access to the Show Hall on the day of the workshop. You will need to show your Confirmation Email so please have it with you at conference.**
- **Please check your SPAM box first then contact the Registrar.**
- Want to change or drop a workshop? Contact Registrar. A fee of \$20.00 plus HST applies, unless within 48 hours after you registered.

Entry Passes (or proof of Workshop Access) are needed to access the Main Show Floor (which includes Vendors, National Juried Show, Concurrent Shows, Challenge Shows and Food Court)

Three types of Entry Passes are available:

Single Day Pass – online \$18.00 incl GST, at the Door \$20.00

Multi Day Pass – \$50.00 (online and at the door)

Same Day Workshop Access – Access to the show hall is included with most workshops (exception is for workshops on Wednesday June 17 and workshops at the University of Alberta on June 20) To enter the Show Hall on the day of your workshop please present your Confirmation Email which shows the words “ENTRY PASS” in the purchased workshop information line below. **This must be shown to enter the Show Hall on the day of your workshop (can only be used on the day of the workshop).**

Workshop Supply Lists:

Check your workshop supply list and Kit Fee information both when you register **and just before you come** to attend the Conference. These links can be found under **the Workshop write up** on the website (the link is below).

Kit fees will be collected at your class by your Classroom Angel. Exact change would be greatly appreciated.

Name Tags (for Workshop participants only) are available at your FIRST CLASS only (be sure that you get them from your classroom assistant). Location of classes are noted on your Supply lists. Please bring the Supply List with you to class.

NOTE: Personal sewing machines will not be allowed in the classrooms. Machines are supplied by our generous sponsors.
