

## Row 1

Row 6 1/2" x 60 1/2"



Block 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Fabric yardage for the quilt for only 5 colours as will be shown in the instructions:

White and pink - Fabric #1 and #2 - 2 yards each Red, green, blue - Fabric #3, #4, #5 - 1 ½ yards each

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>Note in this block, blue is not used.

## **Instructions:**

## **Cutting:**

From pink fabric

Ten 2 ½" x 6 ½"

From green fabric

Ten 2 ½" x 4 ½"

From red fabric

Ten 2 ½" x 4 ½"

From white fabric

Twenty 2 1/2" squares

## Sewing:


With right sides together, sew a white square to one end of the green 2 ½" 4 ½".

With right sides together, sew a white square to one end of the red 2 ½" x 4 ½".

Right sides together, sew the white/green unit to the pink 2 ½" x 6 ½" along the 6 ½" side.

Right sides together, sew the white/red unit to the other side of the pink 2 ½" x 6 ½" along the 6 ½" side.

Make 10 blocks. Sew as shown below. Note that every second block is flipped so it is beside itself with the same colour.
