Row $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


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\text { Block } 61 / 21 \times 61 / 2 \prime
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Fabric yardage for the quilt for only 5 colours as will be shown in the instructions:
White and pink - Fabric \#1 and \#2-2 yards each Red, green, blue - Fabric \#3, \#4, \#5-1 $1 / 4$ yards each

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## Instructions:

## Cutting:

## From pink fabric

Ten $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

From green fabric
Ten $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

From red fabric
Ten $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

From white fabric
Twenty $21 / 2$ " squares

## Sewing:

With right sides together, sew a white square to one end of the green $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
With right sides together, sew a white square to one end of the red $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Right sides together, sew the white/green unit to the pink $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ along the $61 / 2 \prime$ side.
Right sides together, sew the white/red unit to the other side of the pink $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ along the $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side.
Make 10 blocks. Sew as shown below. Note that every second block is flipped so it is beside itself with the same colour.
