



Ribbon Row 2

Brought to you by the Canadian Quilters' Association (CQA/ACC) -
Promoting quilting in Canada, one block at a time.



Row is 6 1/2" x 60 1/2"



Block 6 1/2" x 9 1/2"

Fabric yardage for the quilt for only 5 colours as will be shown in the instructions:

White and pink - Fabric #1 and #2 - 2 yards each

Red, green, blue - Fabric #3, #4, #5 – 1 ¼ yards each

Note: only 3 colours are used for this row.

Instructions:

You will make 9 blocks plus 2 half blocks for the ends of the row.

Cutting:

From pink fabric

Twenty nine 4" squares

From blue fabric

Ten 4" square

From white fabric

Nineteen 4" squares

Two 3 ½" squares

Sewing:


Lay one white and one pink 4" square right sides together. On the white fabric, draw a line on the diagonal. Sew ¼" on either side of diagonal. Cut on drawn line. Open, press your two half square triangles and trim to 3 ½". Make 38 pink/white half square triangles.

Lay one 4" blue square and one 4" pink square right sides together. Draw a line on the diagonal. Sew ¼" on either side of diagonal. Cut on drawn line. Open, press your two half square triangles and trim to 3 ½". Make 20 pink/blue half square triangles.

Lay out block as shown above and sew into rows then sew the rows together. Make 9 blocks as shown above, use the remaining fabric to make the 2 end blocks.

End blocks

Sew 2 as shown below.



Sew the blocks into a row using the end blocks at either end as shown in the row picture.



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
