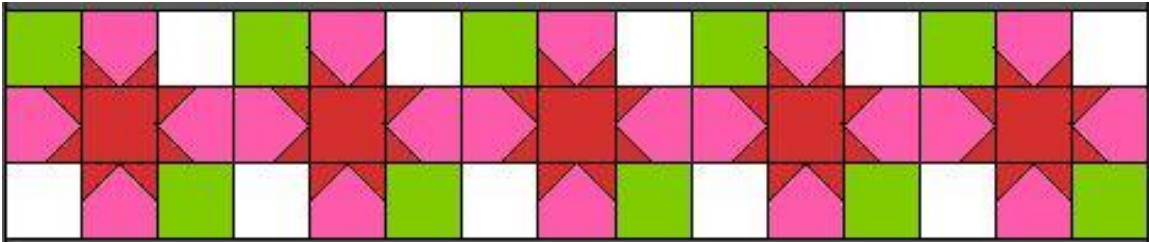
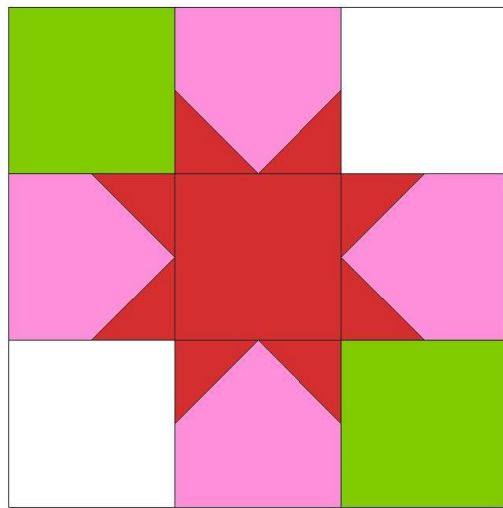


Star Row 3

Brought to you by the Canadian Quilters' Association (CQA/ACC) -
Promoting quilting in Canada, one block at a time.



Row measures 12 ½" x 60 ½"



Block measures 12 ½" x 12 ½"

Fabric yardage for the quilt for only 5 colours as will be shown in the instructions:

White and pink - Fabric #1 and #2 - 2 yards each

Red, green, blue - Fabric #3, #4, #5 - 1 ¼ yards each

***Note: blue is not used in this block.

Instructions:

Cutting:

From pink fabric

Cut twenty 4 ½" squares

From red fabric

Cut five 4 ½" square

Cut forty 2 ½" squares

From green fabric

Cut ten 4 ½" squares

From white fabric

Cut ten 4 ½" squares

Sewing:

On the back of each 2 ½" square, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.

Place a square on the bottom left corner of a pink square and sew on the line. Trim ¼" and press.

Place a square on the bottom right corner of a pink square and sew on the line. Trim ¼" and press. Repeat with remaining 3 pink squares.

Layout the block as shown and sew the 3 units together in rows and then sew the rows together.

Make 5 blocks.
