Row $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


Block $101 / 2 \prime \times 91 / 2 \prime$

Instructions:

## Cutting:

From pink fabric
Nine 4" squares

From blue fabric
Nine 4" squares

From red fabric
Eighteen 4" squares

## From white fabric

Twelve $41 / 2 \prime \times 31 / 2 \prime$
Sewing:

Lay one blue and one red 4" square right sides together. Draw a line on the diagonal. Sew $1 /{ }^{\prime \prime \prime}$ on either side of diagonal. Cut on drawn line. Open, press your two half square triangles and trim to $31 / 2 \prime$. Make 18 blue/red half square triangles.

Lay out as shown below and make 6 units.


Lay one pink and one red $4 "$ square right sides together. Draw a line on the diagonal. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on either side of diagonal. Cut on drawn line. Open, press your two half square triangles and trim to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make 18 pink/red half square triangles.

Lay out as shown below and make 6 units.


Sew a white $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top and bottom of a green $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle along the $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ sides. Repeat 5 times.

Assemble the rows as shown in the block and sew together.

Lay the blocks out, noting that the blocks alternate and sew the row together.


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
