


Instructions:

Cutting:

From pink fabric Nine 4" squares


From blue fabric Nine 4" squares

From green fabric Six 4 ½" x 3 ½" From red fabric Eighteen 4" squares

From white fabric Twelve 4 ½" x 3 ½" Sewing:


Lay one blue and one red 4" square right sides together. Draw a line on the diagonal. Sew ¼" on either side of diagonal. Cut on drawn line. Open, press your two half square triangles and trim to 3 ½". Make 18 blue/red half square triangles.

Lay out as shown below and make 6 units.



Lay one pink and one red 4" square right sides together. Draw a line on the diagonal. Sew ¼" on either side of diagonal. Cut on drawn line. Open, press your two half square triangles and trim to 3 ½". Make 18 pink/red half square triangles.

Lay out as shown below and make 6 units.



Sew a white $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top and bottom of a green $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle along the $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " sides. Repeat 5 times.

Assemble the rows as shown in the block and sew together.

Lay the blocks out, noting that the blocks alternate and sew the row together.



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
