LOG CABIN BLOCK

Quarter-inch seam allowances.

Fabric Requirements

To make one block, please use:

Yellow One 2½" square for center (#1)

White One 2½" x 4½" (#4)

One 2½" x 6½" (#5)

One 2½" x 8½" (#8)

One 2½" x 10½" (#9)

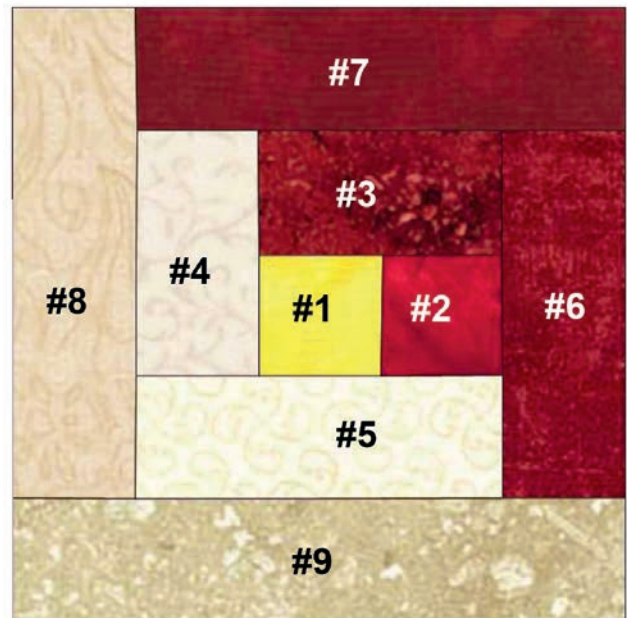
Red One 2½" square (#2)

One 2½" x 4½" (#3)

One 2½" x 6½" (#6)

One 2½" x 8½" (#7)

Eight rows of six blocks (48 blocks) will make a quilt approximately 60" x 80". No borders are needed, simply layer, quilt and bind.



QOVC encourages you and your groups and guilds to make the blocks from Northcott fabric, using not only the *Oh Canada* line of fabric, but any of the beautiful lines from Northcott®. You may also delve into your stash of fabric for red and white to build a Canadian *log cabin* for injured military. The yellow centre symbolizes a welcoming light in the window and the red and white symbolize Canada.
