

Row of the Month  
Row #7 - Houses & Trees

To make up this row, you will need to sew 4 House Blocks, and 2 Tree Blocks. The House Blocks will measure 6" x 9", finished (6.5" x 9.5", unfinished). The Tree Blocks will measure 3" x 6", finished (3.5" x 6.5", unfinished). The Tree Blocks are made using 1.5" x 3", finished (2" x 3.5", unfinished) Flying Geese Units.

Because these are the same sized Flying Geese Units made in Row #5, I am not repeating the directions to make the Flying Geese Units. Please refer to Row #5 instructions.

**Remember to use a scant 1/4" seam throughout.**

## **The House Block**

**Cutting Instructions:** (For *ONE* House Block)

Background Fabric:

Piece Name	Number to Cut	Size to Cut
A	2	1.5" x 3.5"
B	1	1.5" x 1.5"
C	2	2.5" x 2.5"
D	2	1.5" x 3.5"

Scrappy Fabrics:

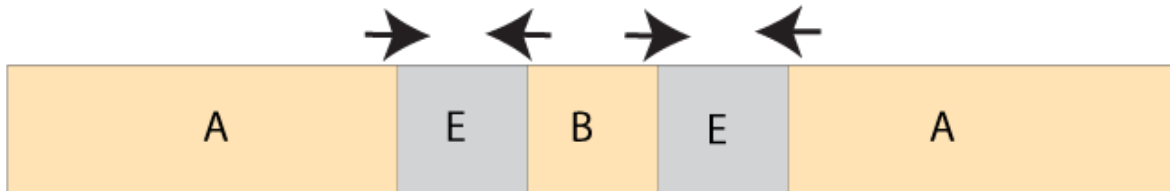
Piece Name	Number to Cut	Size to Cut	Description
E	2	1.5" x 1.5"	Chimneys
F	1	2.5" x 9.5"	Roof
G	1	1.5" x 7.5"	House Front Above Door
H	4	1.5" x 1.5"	House Front Beside Windows
J	2	1.5" x 3.5"	House Front Below Windows
K	1	1.5" x 2.5"	Front Door
L	2	1.5" x 1.5"	Windows



## Piecing Instructions:

### 1. *Chimney Unit:*

Sew together: 2 Fabric A pieces, 1 Fabric B piece, and 2 Fabric E pieces, as indicated in the diagram below. Press seams toward Fabric E pieces.



Chimney Unit should measure 1.5" x 9.5".

### 2. *Roof Unit:*

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric C pieces.

With right sides together, layer a Fabric C piece on one end of the Fabric F piece.

Stitch on the drawn line, and trim 1/4" away from the seam. Press seams as indicated by arrows.



Repeat on the opposite end of the Fabric F piece.

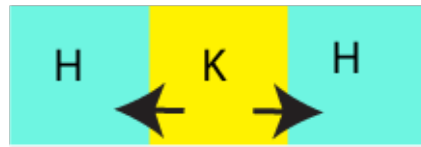


Roof Unit should measure 2.5" x 9.5"



### 3. Window Unit:

Sew together: 2 Fabric H pieces and 1 Fabric K piece, as indicated in the diagram below. Press seams toward Fabric H pieces. Unit should measure 1.5" x 3.5".



Sew 1 Fabric J piece to the bottom of the unit you just made. Press seam toward Fabric J piece. Window Unit should measure 2.5" x 3.5".



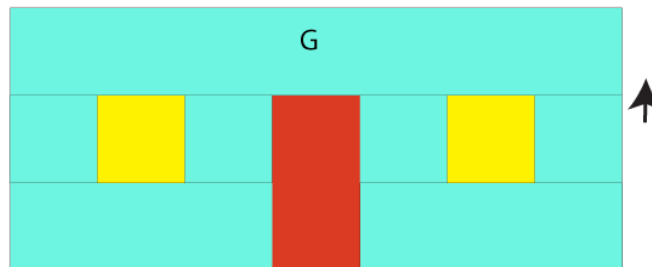
Make a total of 2 Window Units.

### 4. House Front Unit:

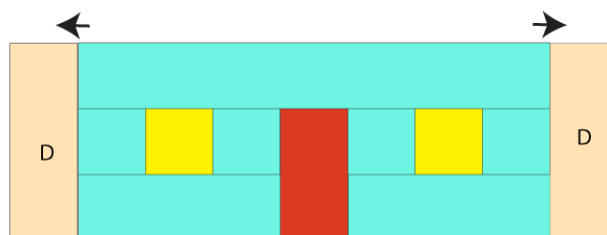
Sew together: 2 Window Units and 1 Fabric L piece, as indicated in the diagram below. Press seams toward the Fabric L piece. Unit will measure 2.5" x 7.5"



Sew 1 Fabric G piece to the top of the unit you just made. Press the seam toward the Fabric G piece. Unit will measure 3.5" x 7.5"

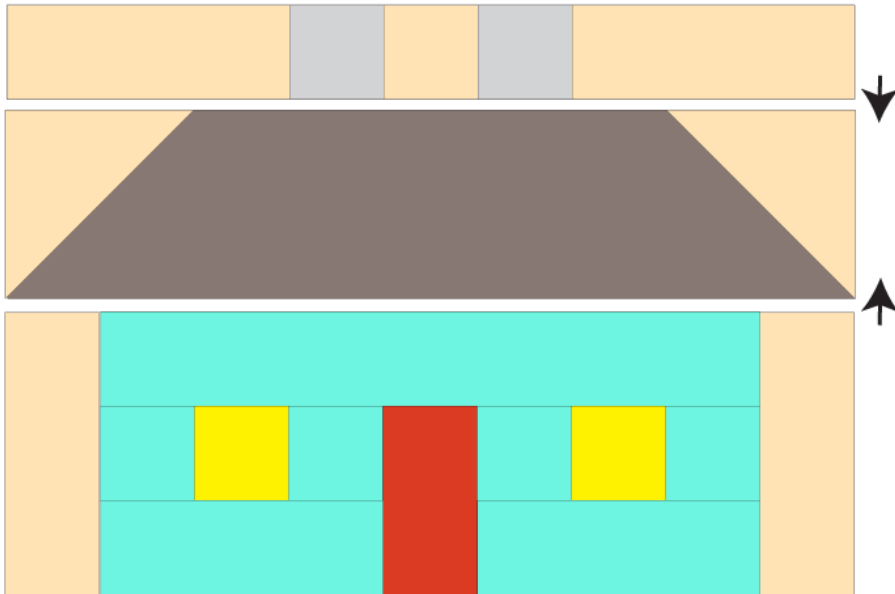


Sew 2 Fabric D pieces to either side of the unit you just made. Press the seams toward the Fabric D pieces. House Front Unit should measure 3.5" x 9.5".

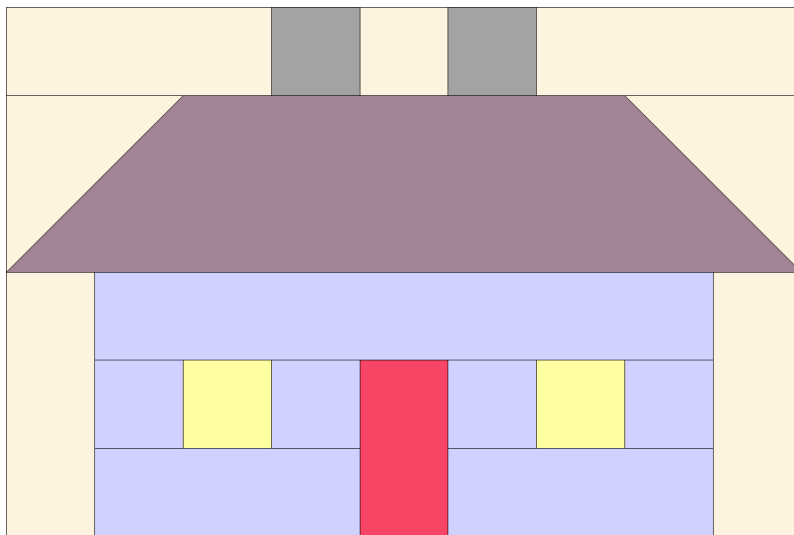


### 5. Assemble House Block:

Sew together: 1 Chimney Unit, 1 Roof Unit, and 1 House Front Unit. Press seams as indicated by arrows in the diagram below.



The House Block should measure 6.5" x 9.5".



Make a total of 4 House Blocks.



## The Tree Block

**Cutting Instructions:** (For *ONE* Tree Block)

Background Fabric:

Piece Name	Number to Cut	Size to Cut	Description
A	6	2" x 2"	Tree Sky Triangles
B	2	1.5" x 1.75"	Trunk Background
C	1	1" x 3.5"	Top Sky

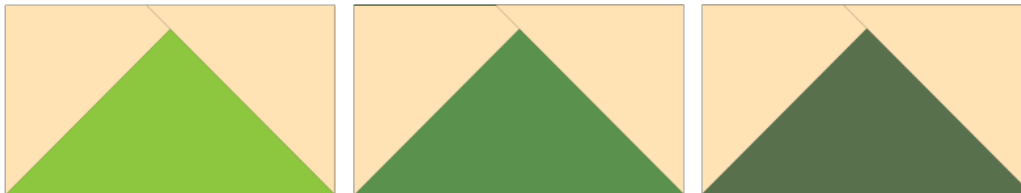
Scrappy Fabrics:

Piece Name	Number to Cut	Size to Cut	Description
D	3	2" x 3.5"	Tree
G	1	1" x 1.5"	Tree Trunk

Piecing Instructions:

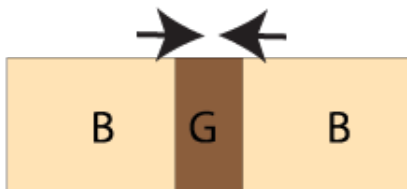
### **1. Flying Geese Units:**

Following instructions given in Row #5, make 3 Flying Geese Units using Fabric pieces A and D. The Flying Geese units should measure 2" x 3.5".



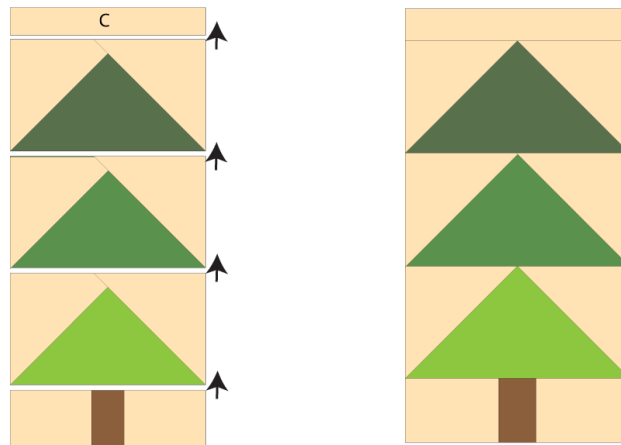
### **2. Tree Trunk Unit:**

Sew together: 2 Fabric B pieces and 1 Fabric G piece, as indicated in the diagram below. Press seams toward Fabric G pieces.



### 3. Assemble the Tree Block:

Sew together: 1 Fabric C piece, 3 Flying Geese Units, and 1 Tree Trunk Unit. Press seams as indicated by arrows in the diagram below.

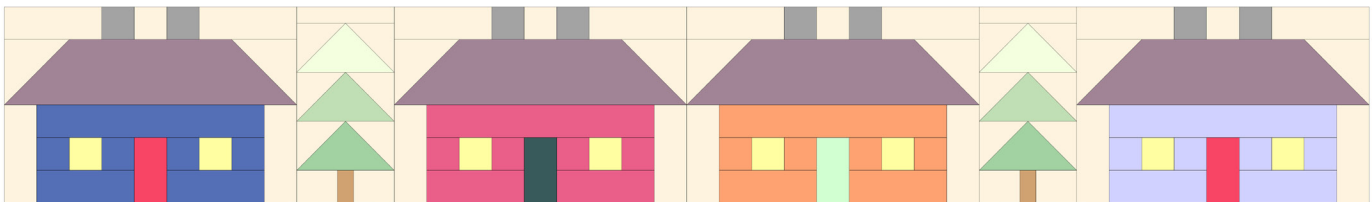


The Tree Block should measure 3.5" x 6.5".

Make a total of 2 Tree Blocks.

### Assemble the Row

Using 4 House Blocks and 2 Tree Blocks, assemble your row as follows:



Press seams to one side or open. It's up to you.

Your Row should measure 6.5" x 42.5".
