Quilt Canada
Supplies:

- Pfaff Expression Sewing machine
- Bobbin
- Ruler foot for the Pfaff Expression machine
- Iron (shared)

Student Supplies:

- #90/14 Topstitch needles; any brand that will work on a pfaff sewing machine
- A 12" arc quilting ruler or similar. I will be using a Westalee Sew Steady quilting ruler to demonstrate in the class, but **any ruler with a straight edge and curved edge that works with the low shank machine (Pfaff Expression) for this class. The ruler should be the 3mm thick type.**
- Favourite quilt marking tool to mark the top of your quilt sandwiches.
- Regular rotary cutting ruler for marking reference lines (6" X 12" would work well).
- A few thread options that are high contrast to your fabric. Threads can include cotton, polyester, and/or rayon. You will fill a bobbin, provided with the Pfaff sewing machine in your classroom, with your selected thread.
- Three or four 18"x22" quilt sandwiches made with muslin or other light or solid fabric. Alternatively, you can have six to eight (or more) 12"x12" quilt sandwiches with light or solid fabric. Avoid busy fabrics. Quilt sandwiches can be basted with thread, spray, or pins.
- Thread snips/ scissors
- Paper & pencil for drawing/practicing the designs and note taking.

Optional:

- Supreme Slider or Sew Slip mat (or something similar), which are brand names of a tacky-backed teflon mat that is placed on your machine bed to eliminate friction and drag as you maneuver your quilt under the needle.
- Grips for your hands- Machingers or Fons & Porter quilting gloves, gardening gloves, hand cream, or anything that can help you to grip your ruler and quilt sandwich.
