Supplies:

- Sewing Machine
- Walking Foot
- Quarter Inch Foot
- Irons & Ironing Mat (shared)

Student Supplies: Project Supplies:

- Rotary Cutter (45mm)
- Cutting Mat
- Ruler
- Sharp Scissors
- Pins
- Marking Tool
- Starch if needed
- Fabric Ruler or template that cuts circles approximately ten inches or larger Suggested rulers:
 - Cut A Round ruler by Cheryl Phillips (www.phillipsfiberart.com) (available for purchase in class).
 - The Circles Savvy Ruler by Creative Grids
 - Note: you need to be able to cut circles that are one inch difference in size. In other words, the hole in the background is one inch smaller in diameter than the circle you are setting in.

Fabric Amounts:

- Several fat quarters...you will need two for each set-in circle.
- Several twenty-inch batting squares (Warm & Natural or something similar) if you plan to quilt some of the blocks individually
