

National Juried Show (NJS) and Concurrent Show Hosts Volunteer Duties

Duties:

- Volunteers are assigned to one of two areas: NJS (10 volunteers per shift) or Concurrent Show (4 volunteers per shift)
- Volunteers wearing white gloves stroll through their designated show area
- Politely discourage anyone from touching the quilts and when asked, offer to show the back of the quilt by lifting a corner with a gloved hand
- Answer visitors' questions about the quilts directing them to signage posted beside the quilts
- Employ excellent customer service skills

Shifts:

- 9:30am – 6 pm June 16 & 17 (4.5 – 6 hour shifts)
- 9:30 am – 4 pm June 18 (4.5 - 6 hour shifts)
- Standing and walking throughout the NJS show area and Concurrent show area
- 10 volunteers per shift in NJS area
- 4 volunteers per shift in the Concurrent area

Attire:

- We are asking volunteers to wear a white top (their choice of style) and dark bottoms (black, navy, dark brown, etc. in a pant, skirt, skort or capri) so that they can be easily identified as volunteers during the open hours of the conference, Thursday through Saturday.
- Comfortable shoes are suggested as concrete floors are hard on legs and feet.
