

## **Ticket Takers at Show Hall Doors Volunteer Duties**

### **Explanation of Entry Passes:**

The following are the types of entry passes utilized at Quilt Canada that allow entry to the show hall/merchant mall:

1. Official Name Badge– for team leads, vendors, teachers, CQA/ACC staff, CQA/ACC Contractors, CQA/ACC Board of Directors, and designator volunteers
2. Paper ticket purchased on-site and/or given to workshop attendees
3. Online ticket with bar code for scanning
4. Multi-day pass holder will have a Tyvek bracelet

### **Duties:**

- Greeting visitors using excellent customer service skills
- Take the paper entry ticket from those that have purchased on site or have from workshop registration  
or
- Scanning those entry passes with scannable barcodes using ePly app on the provided Ipad  
or
- Checking for Quilt Canada Name Tags  
or
- Checking for multi-pass bracelet  
or
- Checking for that day's hand stamp (for those visitors reentering show halls)

### **Shifts:**

- June 16 & 17: 9:15am – 5:00 pm (broken into shifts)
- June 18: 9:00 am - 3:00 pm (broken into shifts)
- 3 volunteers in the morning, 2 volunteers in the afternoon
- Standing during these shifts

### **Attire:**

- We are asking volunteers to wear a white top (their choice of style) and dark bottoms (black, navy, dark brown, etc. in a pant, skirt, skort or capri) so that they can be easily identified as volunteers during the open hours of the conference, Thursday through Saturday.
- Comfortable shoes are suggested as concrete floors are hard on legs and feet.
