

Sun, Sand, and Sea CQA/ACC MEMBER GUILD QUILT CHALLENGE 2023

THE "SUN, SAND, AND SEA" CHALLENGE

- Please choose fabric colours (plain or patterned) that include Yellow, Blue, and Sand (i.e. taupe, beige or even coral) on the front of the quilt.
- The quilt perimeter is to be no larger than 72 inches.
- Each quilt must be finished with either binding, facings, or enveloped pillow-case style.
- There must be a hanging sleeve, at least 3 inches wide, for display purposes.
- · All quilts must have a label on the back with the quilt name and quilter's name visible on it.
- Each CQA/ACC Member Guild selects **one winner only** from their Guild's membership, before April 30, 2023, for entry into this challenge.

ENTRY GUIDELINES

- · Open to CQA/ACC Member Guilds.
- Guilds must email Bonnie Rankin at bonnie.rankin@canadianquilteradministration.com by March 15, 2023, to let CQA/ACC know if their guild intends to participate in the challenge. This will allow CQA/ACC to plan on display space requirements for the show at *Quilt Canada 2023*.
- Once the guild has selected the quilt to represent their guild, the online entry form must be filled out and submitted by April 30, 2023. The online entry form will be located on *Quilt Canada 2023* Guild Challenge page on the canadianquilter.com website. The form will be available January 3, 2023.
- When the online entry form has been received by CQA/ACC, a confirmation email with instructions for shipping the quilt will be sent to the email address supplied on the entry form.
- All quilts must be physically received by May 30, 2023 so they can be displayed at the Halifax Convention Centre, June 8-10, 2023.
- The winning quilt will be selected by Viewers' Choice during *Quilt Canada 2023* and awarded a \$100 cash prize.

Note: Your submitted piece may be kept for a year to be part of a CQA/ACC touring trunk show to promote *Quilt Canada 2024* in Edmonton, Alberta. ▼
