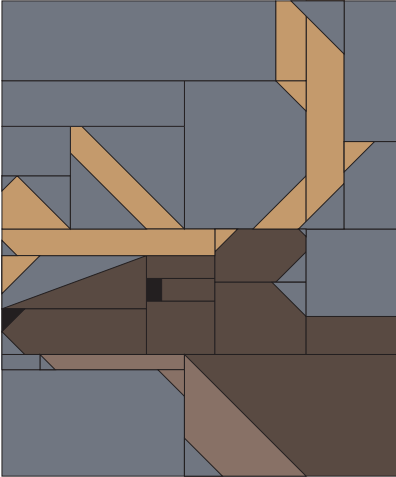


\$3.31 Quilt - the Caribou

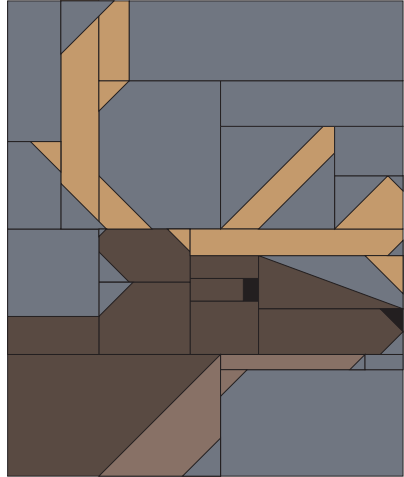
Our third block celebrates the caribou as found on the quarter since 1937. This block has a finished size of 26" x 31.25".

If you are making the lap size quilt, you will need one caribou block. If you are making the queen size version, you will need to create two of these blocks in mirror image from one another. Graphics are provided to create the block facing both directions.

Block facing right

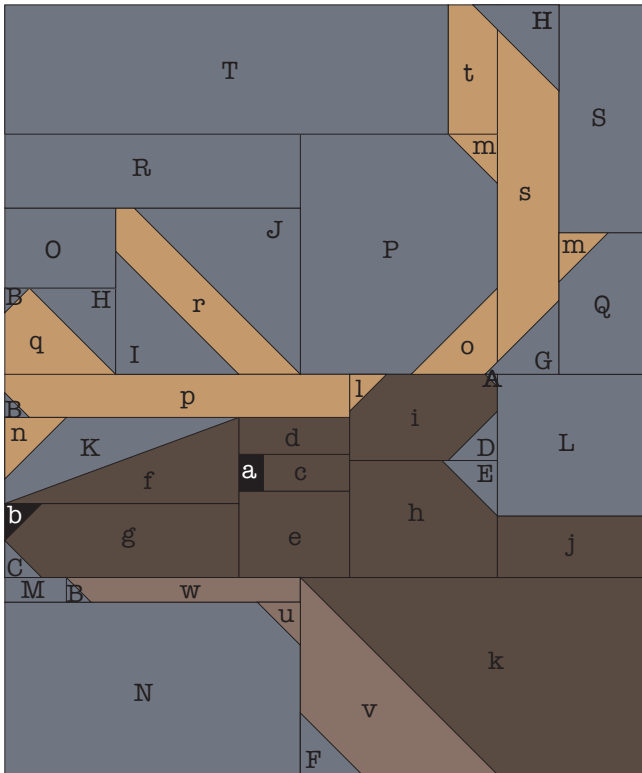
Queen size only, make 1

Note that all BACKGROUND pieces are marked with capital letters and all other pieces are marked with lowercase letters.

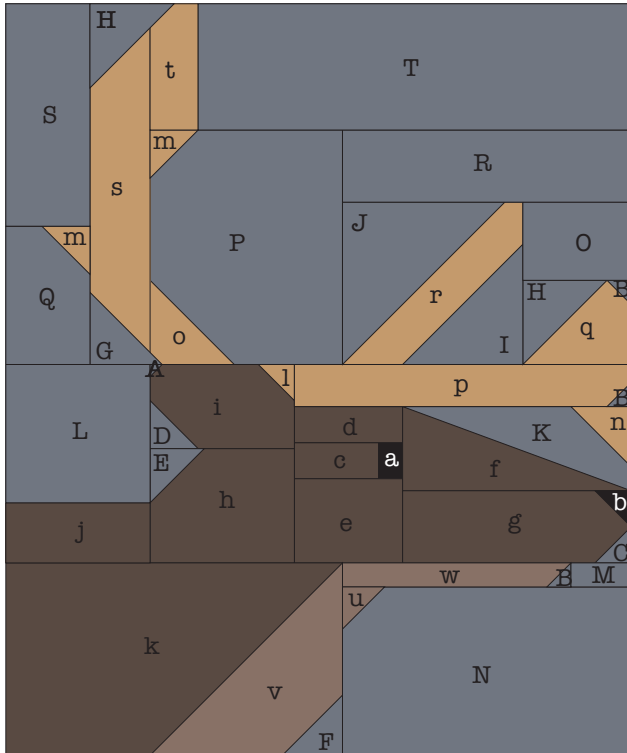

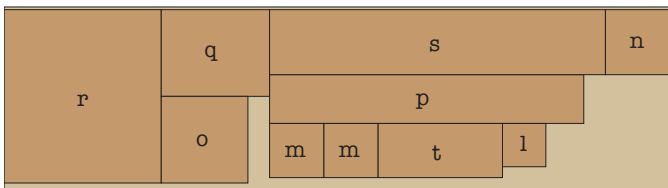

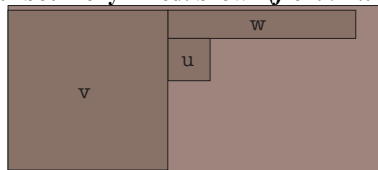

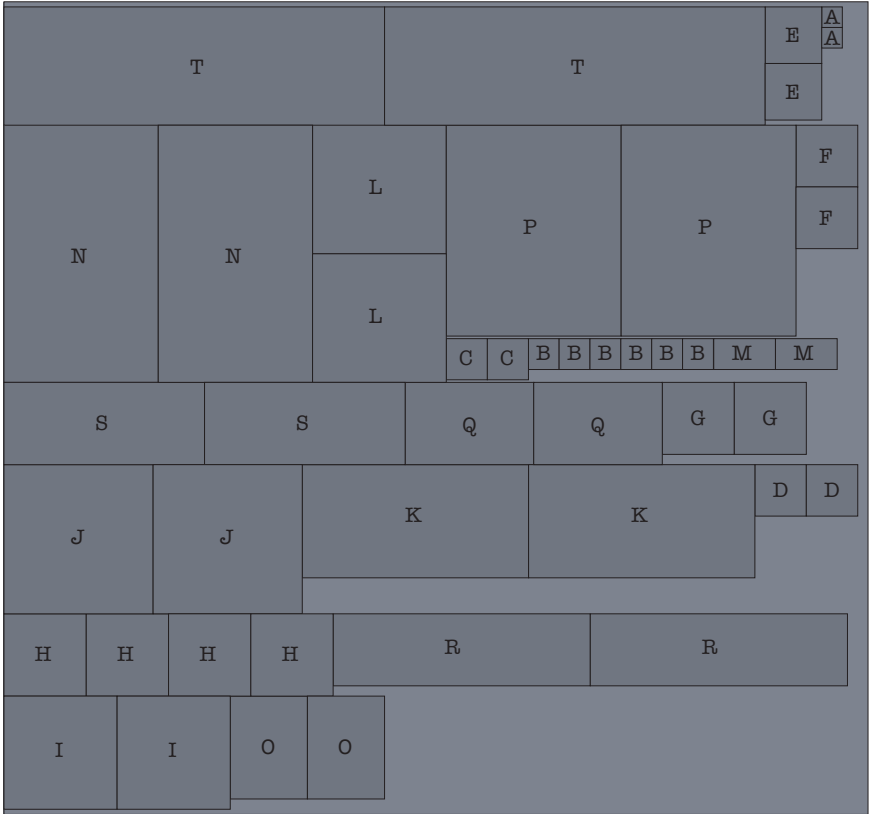


Caribou Belly - med. brown (from 9" x 20")

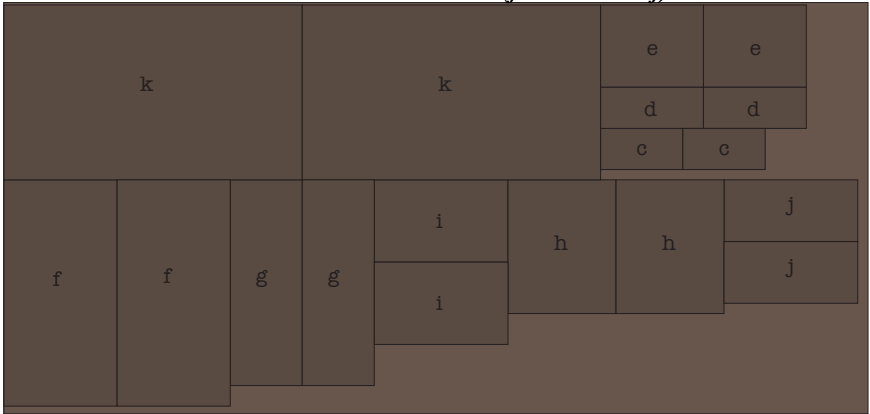

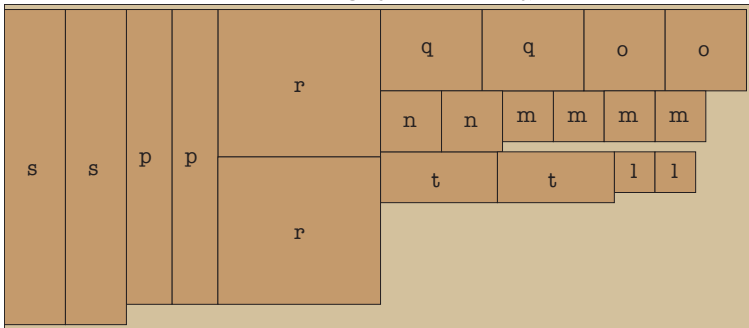

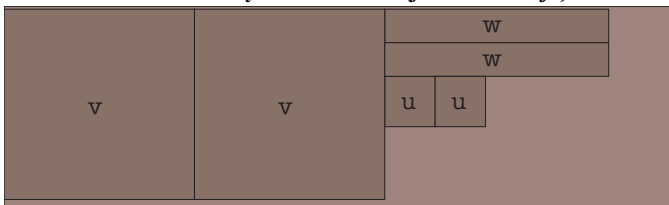

STEP 1 -Top Head Unit

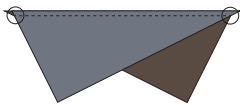
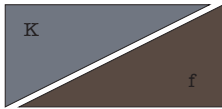
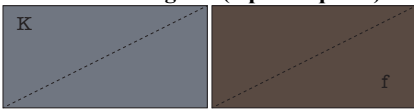
Be sure to follow the diagrams of the version(s) of the block you are making, facing left, facing right or both.

Cut piece **K** and piece **f** in half diagonally, as shown.

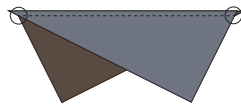
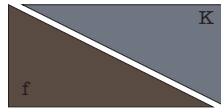
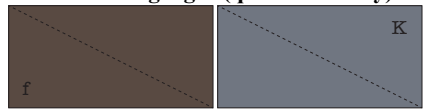
Sew two halves of these pieces together along the long diagonal side, as shown. *The dimension of this unit should be approximately 10" x 5.25".*

Note that when you sew these together, you should have an overhang on either side of the seam allowance edge. The outer edges of these pieces should meet 1/4" down from the diagonal edges, as shown.

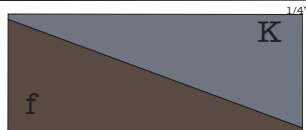
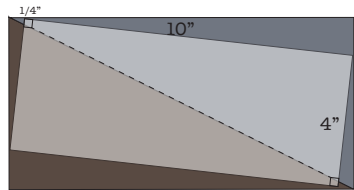
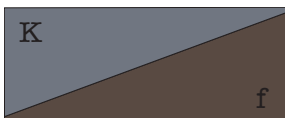
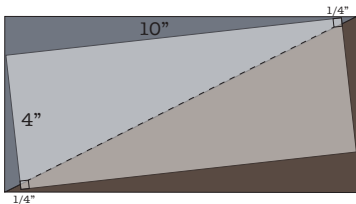


Block facing right (queen size only)



Once pressed, trim the **K/f** unit to measure 10" x 4.5" in a way that the seam the unit in half with the seam intersecting the point 1/4" in from the two opposing corners.

To do this, you can create a template using template plastic or tracing paper. Trace a rectangle that measures 10" x 4". In two opposing corners, draw two 1/4" squares representing the seam allowance. Connect the two inner most corners of the squared with a line representing the seam on the unit, as shown.



Stitch & flip piece **n** to the top corner of the **K/f** unit on the side of the full corner of the **K** piece, as shown. Trim and press.

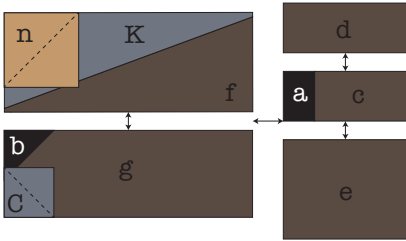
Stitch & flip piece **b** and the **C** piece to one side of the **g** piece, trimming and pressing in between.

Stitch the **K/f/n** unit to the top of the **g/b/C** unit, creating the **Snout Unit**. *This unit should measure 10" x 7"*.

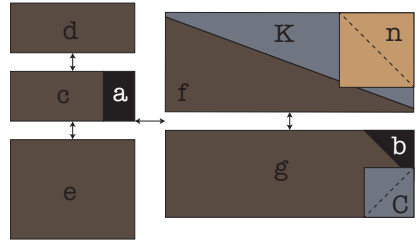
Stitch piece **a** to piece **c**, as shown. Once pressed, stitch piece **d** to the top of the **a/c** unit and piece **e** to the bottom, as shown, creating the **Eye Unit** (5" x 7").

Once pressed, stitch the **Eye Unit** to the **Snout Unit**, as shown, creating the **Face Unit** (14.5" x 7").

Block facing left (lap and queen)



Block facing right (queen size only)



Stitch & flip a **B** piece to one of the bottom corners of piece **p**, as shown on the next page.

Once trimmed and pressed, stitch the **p/B** unit to the top of the **Face Unit**, as shown on the next page (14.5" x 8.75").

Stitch & flip the **A** piece, the **I** piece and piece **D** to three corners of the **i** piece, as shown on the next page. Trim and press.

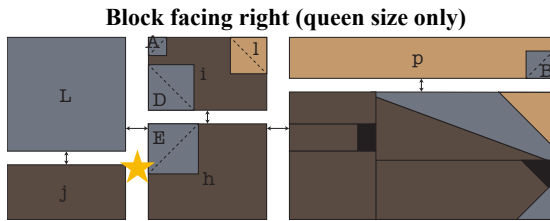
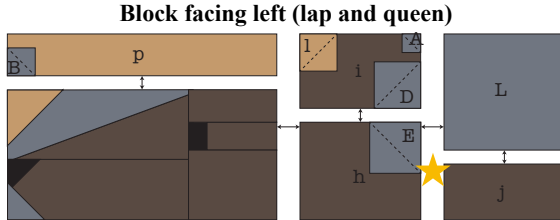
Stitch & flip the **E** piece to one of the top corners of the **h** piece, as shown on the next page.

Once trimmed and pressed, stitch the **I/A/I/D** unit to the top of the **h/E** unit, as shown on the next page, creating the **Ear Unit** (6.5" x 8.75").

Stitch piece **L** to the top of piece **j**, as shown on the next page (6.5" x 8.75").

Once pressed, stitch the **L/j** unit, the **Ear Unit** and the **p/B/Face Unit** in a sequence, as shown, completing the **Top Head Unit** (26.75" x 8.75").

★ When you do this, you will want to match the point where the seam created by pieces **L** and **j** meets the seam created by pieces **E** and **h**, as marked on the diagram by a star.



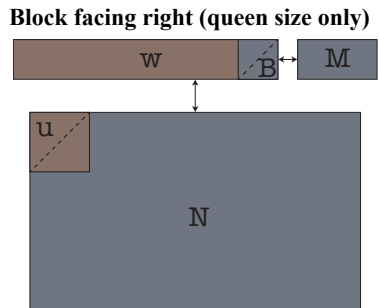
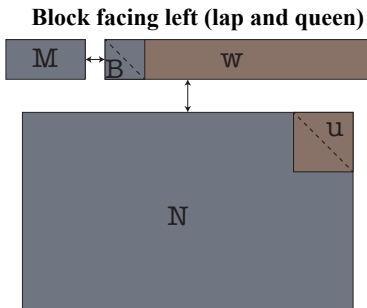
STEP 2 - Lower Head Unit

Stitch & flip one of the **B** piece to one of the bottom corners of piece **w**, as shown.

Once trimmed and pressed, stitch piece **M** to the side of the **w/B** unit, as shown (12.5" x 1.5").

Stitch & flip piece **u** to one of the top corners of piece **N**, as shown.

Once trimmed and pressed, stitch the **M/w/B** unit to the top of the **N/u** unit, as shown, creating the **Chin Unit** (12.5" x 8.5").

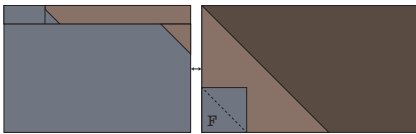
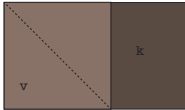


Stitch & flip the **v** piece to one of the bottom corners of piece **k**, as shown.

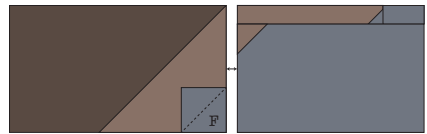
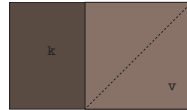
Once trimmed and pressed, stitch & flip the **F** piece to the same corner as the **v** piece, as shown.

Once trimmed and pressed, stitch the **k/v/F** unit to the side of the **Chin Unit**, as shown, completing the **Lower Head Unit** (26.5" x 8.5").

STEP 3 - Antler Unit

Stitch and flip one of the **B** pieces and piece **H** to opposing corners of piece **q**, as shown.

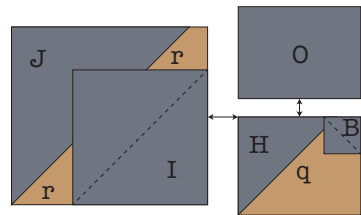
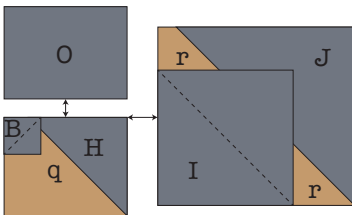
Once trimmed and pressed, stitch piece **O** to the top of the **q/B/H** unit (5" x 7.25").

Stitch & flip piece **I** and piece **J** to opposing corners of piece **r**, as shown.

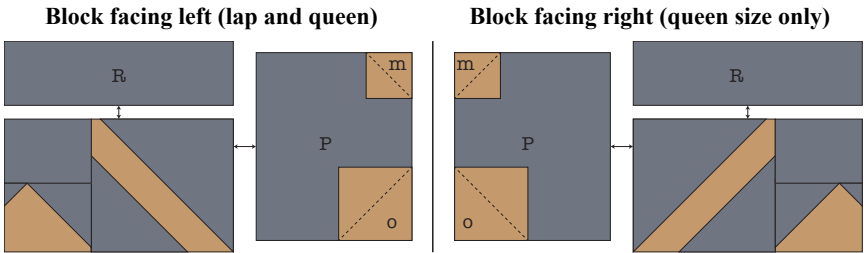
Once trimmed & pressed, stitch the **r/J/I** unit to the side of the **O/q/B/H** unit, as shown, creating the **Front Antler Unit** (12.5" x 7.25").

Once pressed, stitch piece **R** to the top of the **Front Antler Unit**, as shown on the next page (12.5" x 10.25").

Stitch & flip one of the **m** pieces and piece **o** to one side of the **P** piece, as shown on the next page.



Once trimmed and pressed, stitch the **P/m/o** unit to the side of the **R/Front Antler Unit**, as shown (20.5" x 10.25").

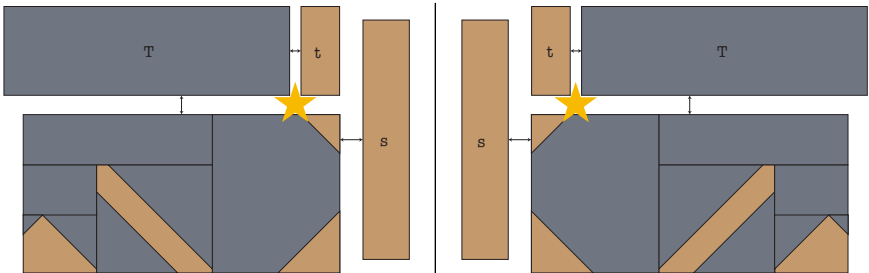


Stitch piece **T** to piece **t**, as shown (20.5" x 5.75").

Once pressed, stitch the **T/t** unit to the top of the previously created unit, as shown (20.5" x 15.5").

★ When you do this, you will want to match the point where the seam created by piece **T** and **t** meets the seam created by piece **P** and **m**, as marked on the diagram by a star.

Once pressed, stitch piece **s** to the side of the unit, as shown, creating the **Main Antler Unit** (23" x 15.5").



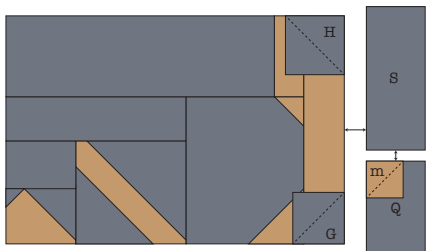
Once pressed, stitch & flip the **H** and **G** pieces to the piece **s** side of the **Main Antler Unit**, as shown on the next page.

Stitch & flip piece **m** to one of the top corners of piece **Q**, as shown.

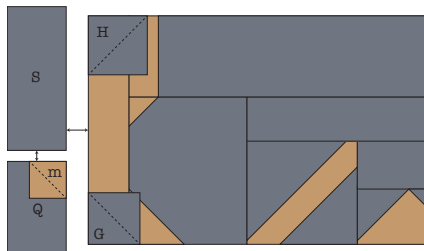
Once trimmed and pressed, stitch the **S** piece to the top of the **Q/m** unit, as shown on the next page (4" x 15.5").

Once pressed, complete the **Antler Unit** by stitching the **S/Q/m** unit to the side of the **Main Antler Unit**, as shown on the next page (26.5" x 15.5"). Press.

Block facing left (lap and queen)



Block facing right (queen size only)



Complete the block by stitching the **Antler Unit**, the **Upper Head Unit** and the **Lower Head Unit** in a sequence as shown.

The dimensions of the completed block should measure $26'' \times 31.75''$.
