// FPP Templates - Some foundation templates to use in class will be provided. However, if you have a foundation paper preference, you're welcome to prepare your own templates to bring to class.

- Fabric: See pattern cover for fabric amounts. One fat quarter (18" x 22") yields two quilt blocks. Once cut for the various house sections—roof, back-ground, house and trim—these fabrics can be mixed and matched as desired to create individual houses. Mix and match as desired, OR make all of your houses the same by adjusting the fabric amounts accordingly. If you are unsure--don't worry! We'll discuss fabric strategies and planning in class.
