Supplies:

- sewing machine & bobbin
- Iron (shared)

Student Supplies:

- Pencil (2B)
- Eraser
- scotch tape
- black medium felt tipped marker (Sharpie)
- Rotary cutter
- patchwork ruler
- cutting board
- 1 -2 metres of 24 inch wide Steam a seam 2 Lite
- Threads - size 40 or 50 to match background and foreground fabrics. Variegated threads work well.
- Neutral thread for the bobbin (to be wound in class)
- Machine needles – size 90 topstitch needles, pins
- Scissors fabric and paper. Small sharp scissors, tweezers, seam ripper
- Appliqué mat or sheets of baking parchment paper

Fabric

- 60 cms of white cotton fabric for the base.
- Collaged background tiles– Could be sky or forest
- 10—12 fabrics that blend well together and range from light to dark. The important thing is for the fabrics to blend or overlap so that the colour graduations are quite subtle. Batiks, landscape prints, and hand-dyed fabrics can work well together. (1/4 metres, fat quarters )
- Fabric for foreground and trees or buildings.
- Only small amounts (fat 1/8th) of each is needed.
- Backing and Batting
- Batting 50 x 70 cms. Thin batting such as cotton works well. The batting is used early in the process. Backing fabric – 1 metre for backing and facings.
