Supplies:

- sewing machine
- Iron (shared)

Student Supplies:

- Pencil, eraser, cello tape, black medium felt tipped marker (e.g. Sharpie)
- Rotary cutter, patchwork ruler, cutting board (bring the longest ruler you can)
- Pins, chalk pen or chalk marker (I will have some available for use in class)
- 1 metre of Freezer Paper
- 1 metre of 24 in wide Steam a seam 2 Lite – (can be narrower but bring more)
- Thread to blend with background and foreground fabrics.
- Size 90 topstitch needles
- Scissors (both fabric and paper), Seam Ripper, tweezers
- Batting – 50 x 40 cms

Fabric for tiled background

Bring a range of fabrics that blend well together in the colors needed for the background. It may work out that you actually only use one or a small number of fabrics if they contain a range of colours and value. The important thing is for the fabrics to blend or overlap so that the color graduations are quite subtle. ¼ metres or fat quarters suitable.

Foreground- Choose fabrics to match your foreground details such as trees, buildings, foliage etc

Backing facing fabric - ½ metre

Note – There will be suitable hand dyed fabric available for purchase in class
