- a large variety of quality coloured papers from which to work

Quilt Canada Supplies:

- shared irons

Student Supplies:

- Fabric will be provided, but you can bring your own if you have any with personal significance you would like to use in your project.
- Needles: Any hand sewing needles that you have on hand will work. I have found that I enjoy Chenille Number 22 needles. The eye is rather large, which allows for easy threading, and the end is sharp enough to pierce through a few layers of fabric.
- Threads: I use a wide variety of embroidery floss colours. I use anywhere from 1 strand to all 6 strands of floss. I encourage you to search through your supplies. I also enjoy using yarns, sewing machine weight threads, sashiko thread, etc.
- Scissors: Any sharp scissors or snips you have on hand will do the trick.
- Glue stick: I suggest using a temporary glue stick, like what a child would use in school. I use an Elmer's disappearing purple glue stick. You can also use pins or safety pins if desired. Personally, I don't enjoy working around them and then having to remove them.
