READ ALL DIRECTIONS PRIOR TO BEGINNING

1. All of the pattern pieces are mirrored and are shown without a seam allowance.
2. All foundation paper-pieced units have been mirrored and are shown with a ¼" seam allowance.

Unit One: Light The Way

INSTRUCTIONS

Cut the following pieces for the main background unit. Set aside all extra fabric for the rest of the quilt.

BACKGROUND (Foundation Paper-Pieced method)

CUT:

Candy Green (1061):

- 2- 5" x 10" for unit BA (left light beacon)
- 2- 5" x 5½" for unit BB (right light beacon)
- 1- 12½" x 17½" for piece BC (middle space)

Duckling (840):

- 2 - 3½" x 9½" for unit BA
- 2 - 3" x 8" for unit BB

Grelow (476):

- 2 - 4½" x 8½" for units BA & BB

Astral (484):

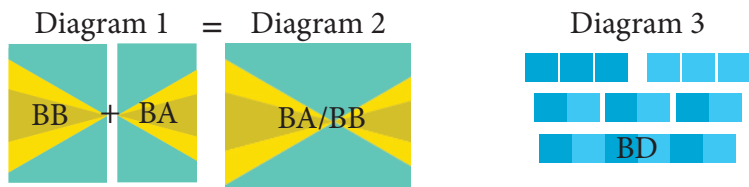
- 3 - 2½ Square pieces for piece BD (checkerboard unit)

Bahama (1011):

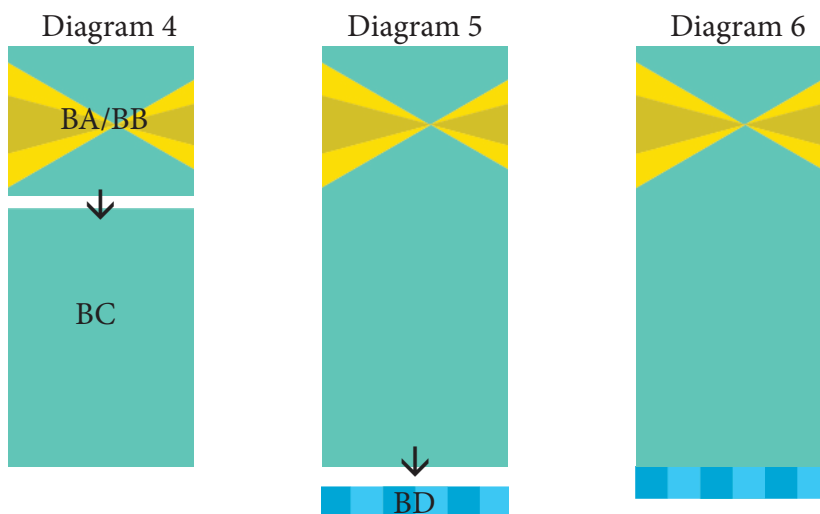
- 3 - 2½ square pieces for piece BD

Assembly of Background Unit:

1. Cut all fabric as direct.
2. Print Foundation Paper Pieces (FPP) single-sided on letter-size paper. Ensure that the one (1) inch reference square on each page (pages 6 & 7) is accurate prior to using.
3. Using your preferred method of FPP assemble **unit BA** & **unit BB**. (Diagram 1)
4. Join **unit BA** to **unit BB**. (Diagram 2)
5. Create **unit BD** by alternating colours of the 6 - 2½” squares; stitch together to make a 2½ x 12½” rectangle. (Diagram 3)
6. Connect **unit BA/BB** to **unit BC**. (Diagram 4)



7. Join **unit BA/BB/BC** to **unit BD**. (Diagram 5)



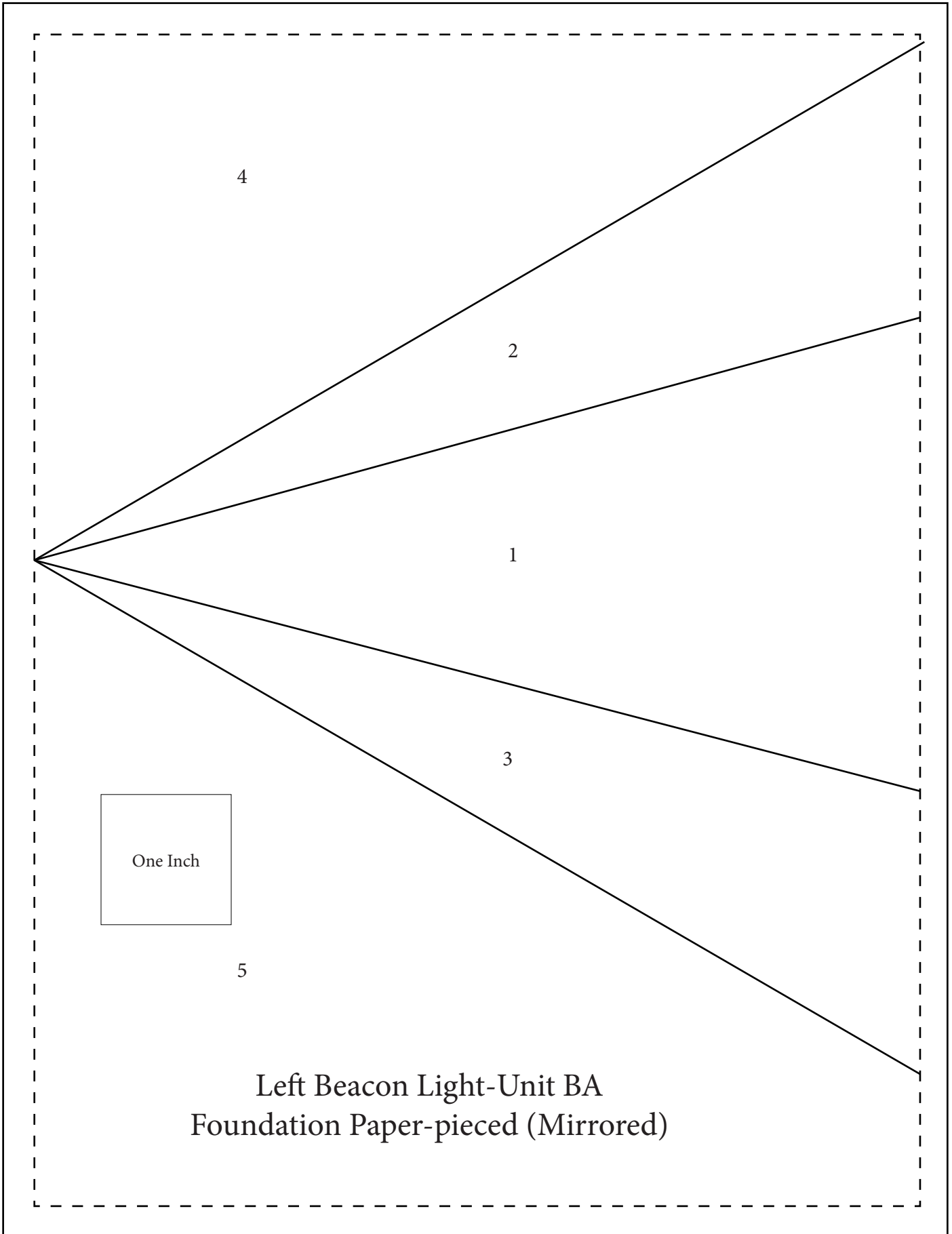
8. Construct the background by piecing together; **(BA/BB)** light beacon, **(BC)** middle-ground and **(BD)** checkerboard 6-piece horizontal. (Diagram 6)

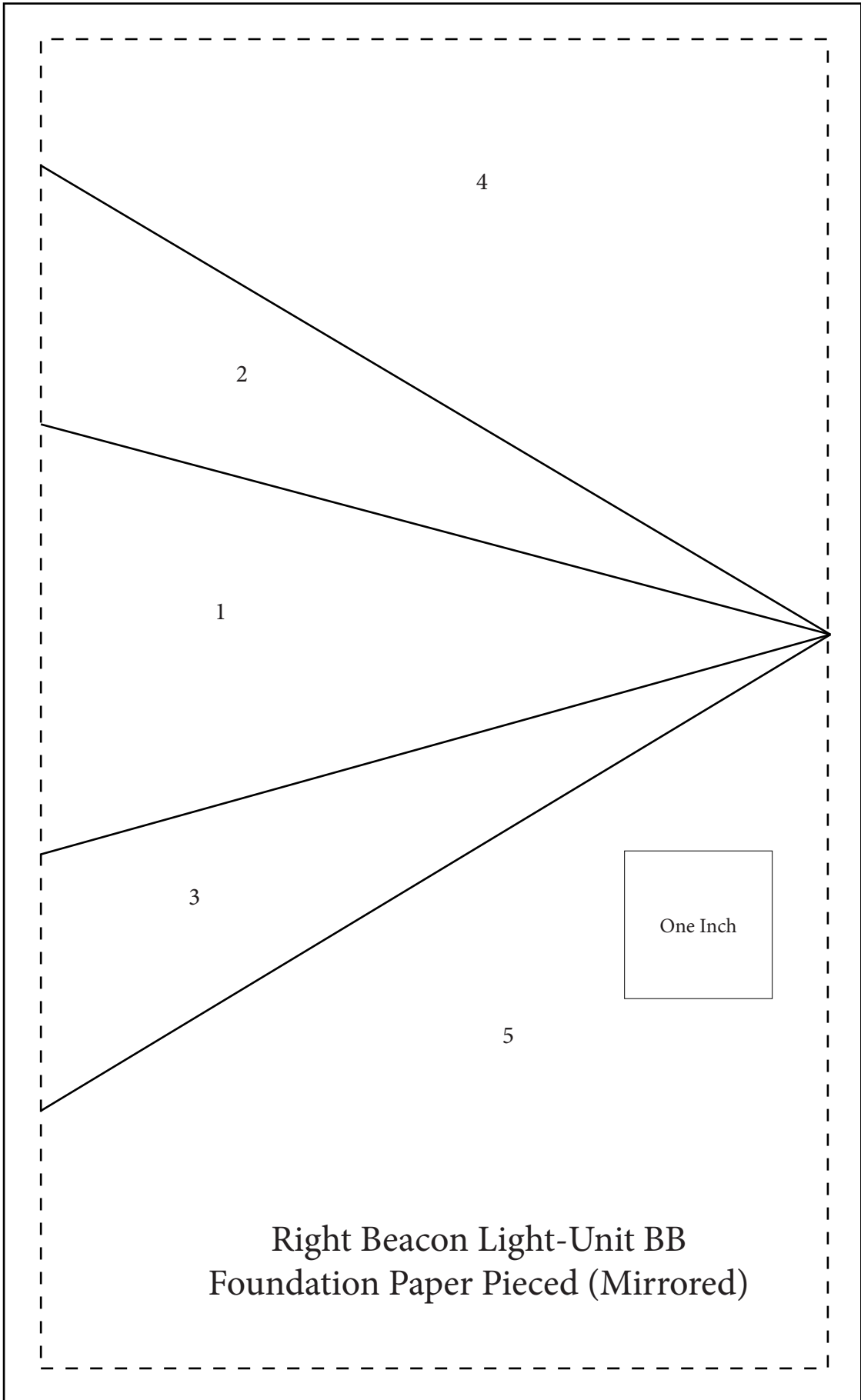
Applique:

Using your preferred method of applique and following manufacturers instructions; trace, cut-out and assemble all pieces according to the design layout. Templates are provided full size & mirrored. Using the placement guide as reference place all pieces onto the background unit.

Finishing:

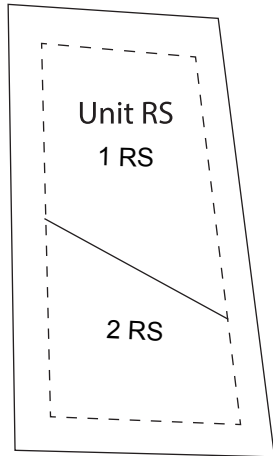
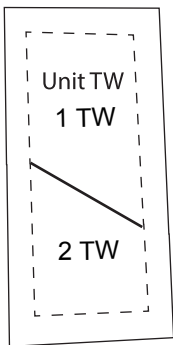
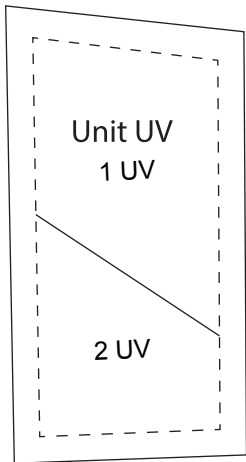
Unit one is the first of five units. Set aside to create the full (50" x 36") Sea You in Nova Scotia quilt or complete using your preferred method.



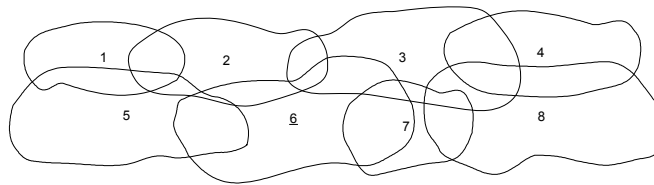
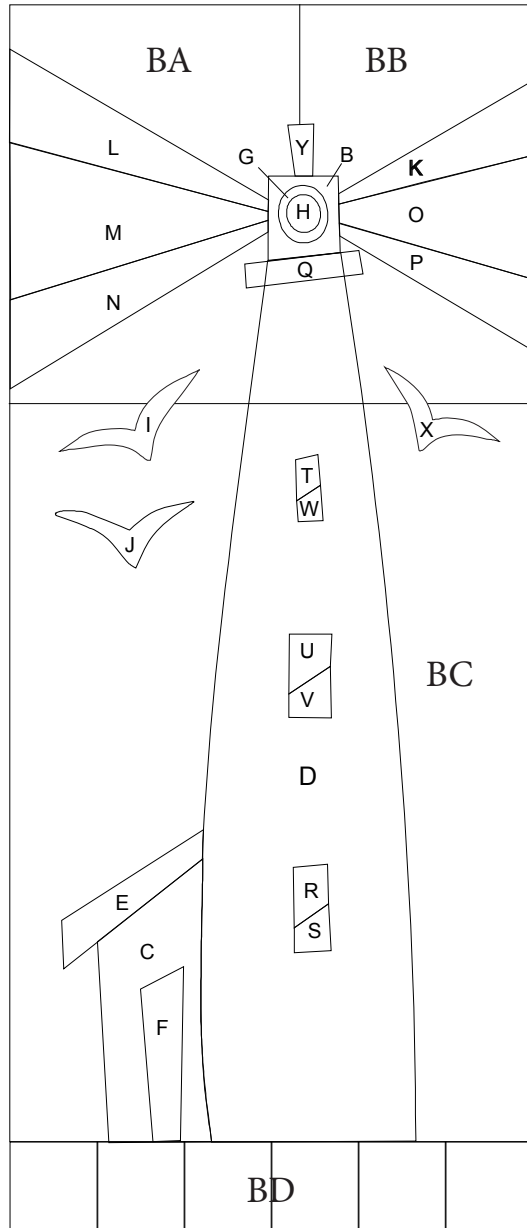


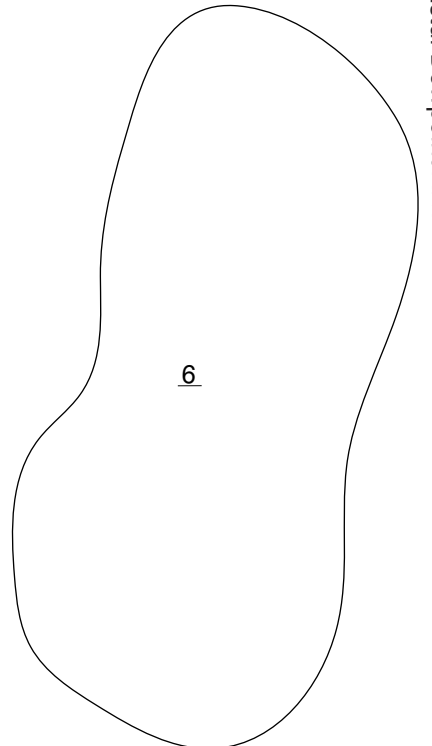
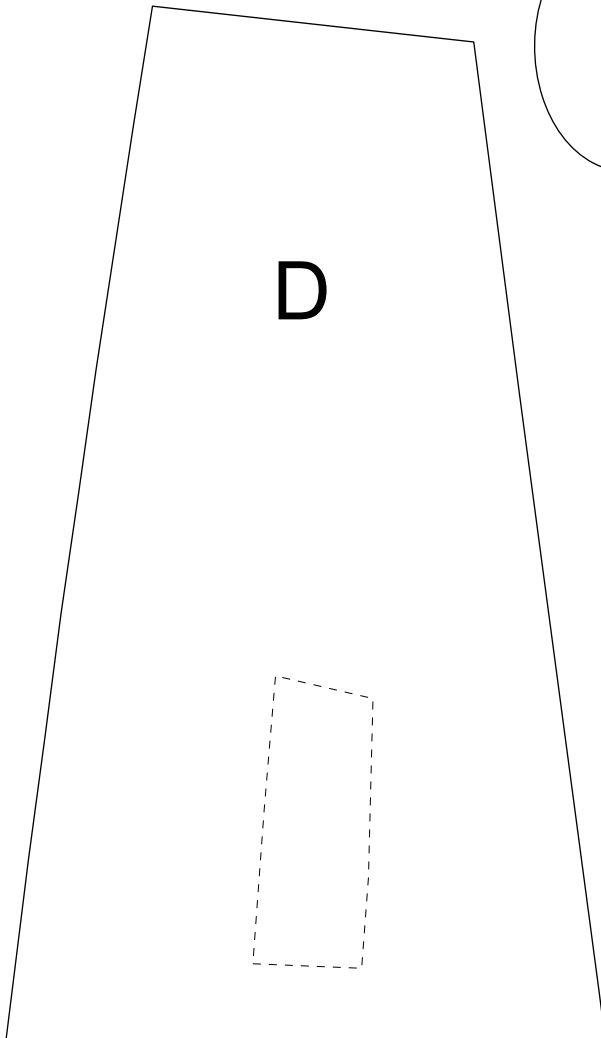
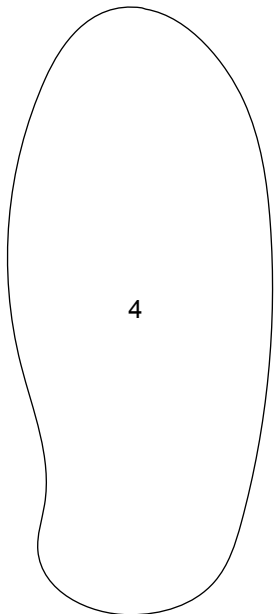
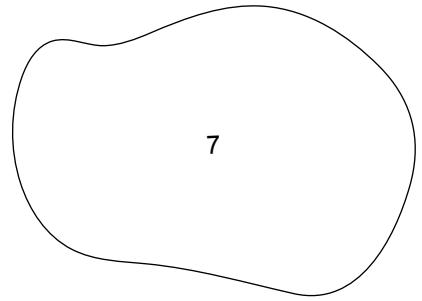
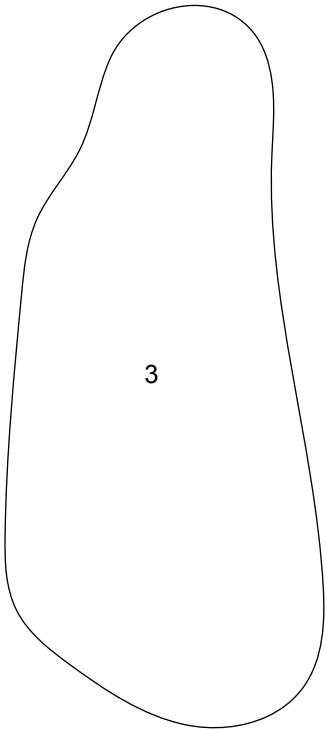
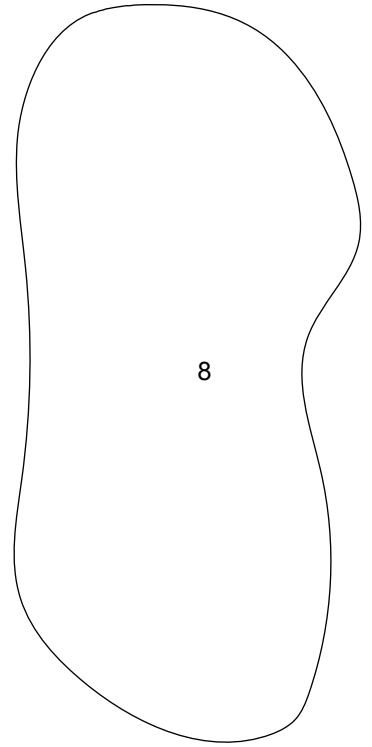
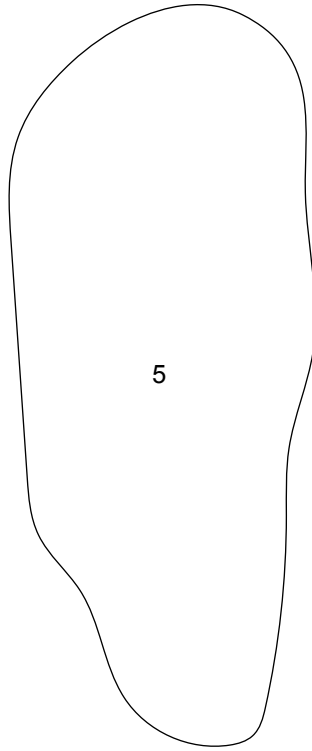
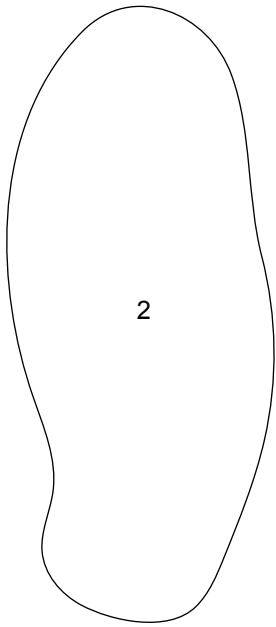
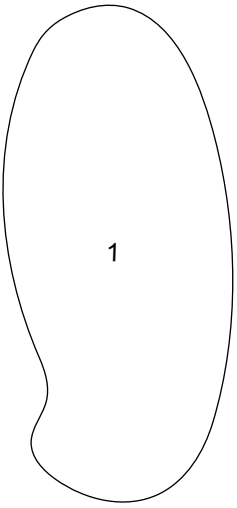
Right Beacon Light-Unit BB

Lighthouse Window Units Foundation Paper Pieced (Mirrored)

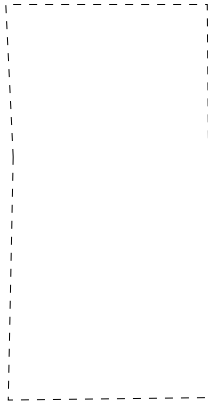


Light The Way Applique Placement Guide





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
