

National Juried Show (NJS) Judging Room Assistants

Duties:

- Assists in the NJS Judging Room as quilt fanner/holder/runner/folder; holds up quilts for judges to view
- Assists the Past President in keeping all of the quilts sorted by category, hold the quilts for the judges to view, ensures that quilts not considered for prizes are carefully removed and stacked by category for hanging in the NJS

Prerequisites:

- General knowledge of Quilt Canada 2023
- Review, familiarize yourself and sign to agree with the guidelines for judging room etiquette prior to the start of judging; see attachment for details.
- Confidentiality Agreement must be signed before judging commences understanding that all comments in the judging room are confidential and must not be shared with anyone.
 - Must not have a quilt accepted into the 2023 NJS

Shifts:

Please note that volunteers must be willing to stay for the entire day of their shift.

- June 4: volunteers required from noon – 6:00 pm (possibly could run later depending on judging progress)
- June 5: volunteers required from 9:00 am – 6:00 pm (possibly could run later than 6 pm – there will be a lunch break and if needed a supper break)
- June 6: volunteers possibly required from 9:15 to noon

Attire:

- Dress appropriately for the location of the judging. The rooms may fluctuate in temperature so plan to dress in layers.
- Comfortable closed-toed shoes are suggested for long periods of time standing.
