\$3.31 Quilt - Quilt Assembly

The last step in making the \$3.31 Quilt is bringing all of our blocks together with sashing and borders to form the completed quilt top.

Note that there are separate cutting guides and directions for the lap and queen size quilt.





LAP SIZE - Quilt Top Assembly

Stitch the **G** piece and the **F** piece to the top and bottom of the **Large Leaf Block**, as shown (21.75" x 31.75").

Once pressed, stitch the **Moose Block** to the right of the **Large Leaf Block/G/F** unit, as shown, creating the **Top Row** (47.75" x 31.75").




Stitch piece **E** and piece **D** to sides of one of the **Small Leaf Blocks**, as shown $(21.75" \times 10")$.

Once pressed, stitch the **Small Leaf Block/E/D** unit to the top of the **Beaver Block**, as shown (21.75" x 24.5").


Stitch the **B** and **C** pieces to the sides of another one of the **Small Leaf Blocks**, as shown $(26.5" \times 10")$.

Once pressed, stitch the **Polar Bear Block** to the top of the **Small Leaf Block/B/C** unit, as shown (26.5" x 24.5").

Once pressed, stitch the **Polar Bear/Small Leaf Block** unit to the **Beaver/Small Leaf Block** unit, as shown, creating the **Centre Row**, as shown (47.75" x 24.5").




Create the **Bottom Row** by stitching the **Loon Block**, the two **A** pieces and the remaining **Small Leaf Block** in a sequence, as shown (47.75" x 10").



Stitch the **Top Row**, the **Centre Row**, the **Bottom Row** and both **H** pieces in a sequence, as shown (47.75" x 73.25").

Once pressed, stitch the I pieces to either side of the quilt and press, completing the quilt top $(55.75" \times 73.25")$.




QUEEN SIZE - Quilt Top Assembly

Stitch the L/Right Facing Double Leaf Block unit to the right of the Right Facing Loon Block, as shown, and press (46" x 10").

Stitch the **Left Facing Beaver Block**, the **M/M/Right Facing Double Leaf Block** unit and two **C** pieces in a sequence, as shown (46" x 15").

Once pressed, stitch both previously created units and both $\bf A$ pieces in a sequence, as shown (46" x 31.75").

Once pressed, stitch this unit, piece **B** and the **Left Facing Moose Block** in a sequence, creating the **Top Row**, as shown (75.25" x 31.75"). Press and place aside.





Stitch the **F** piece to the bottom of the **Left Facing Loon Block**, as shown (29.75" x 12.5").

Once pressed, stitch the **F/Loon Block** unit, the **12" Leaf Block** and the two **E** pieces in a sequence, as shown (49.25" x 12.5").

Once pressed, stitch the **D** piece to the top of this new block, as shown (49.25" x 15").

Once pressed, stitch the **Right Facing Polar Bear Block** to the left of the unit, as shown, completing the **Centre Row** (75.25" x 15").





Stitch the **Left Facing Double Leaf Block**, the **Right Facing Beaver Block** and the two remaining **C** pieces in a sequence, as shown (46" x 15").

Stitch the I piece to the top of the **Left Facing Polar Bear Block**, as shown (26.5" x 17.25").

Once pressed, stitch the I/Polar Bear Block unit, the N/O/Double Leaf Block and piece H in a sequence, as shown (46" x 17.25").

Once pressed, stitch the **Beaver/Double Leaf Block** unit to the top of the **Polar Bear/ Double Leaf Block** unit, as shown (46" x 31.75").

Once pressed, stitch this unit, the **Right Facing Moose Block** and piece **B** in a sequence and press, as shown, creating the **Bottom Row** (75.25" x 31.75").

Stitch the **Top Row**, the **Centre Row**, the **Bottom Row**, the two **J** pieces and piece **G** in a sequence, as shown (75.25" x 90.5").

Once pressed, complete the quilt top by stitch the two **K** border pieces to either side of the quilt top $(90.5" \times 90.5")$.
