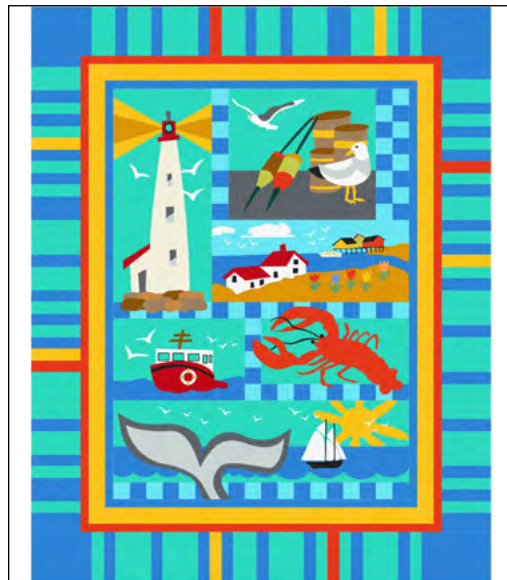

Sea You In Nova Scotia

Optional Border Fabric Requirements

Fabric width 44-45 Kona Solids

KONA Reference	Yardage		WOF (40" - 45")
Astral (#484) (a medium blue)	1 Yard	First border 1" and piano key border	Cut (3) WOF 1 ½" strips; join strips, then sub-cut into: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (2) 52 ½" X 1 ½" strips. Cut (2) WOF 1 ½" strips; sub-cut into: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (2) 36 ½" X 1 ½" border strips. Cut (4) WOF 6 ½" strips; then, sub-cut into: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (45) 6 ½" X 2" pieces. (4) 6 ½" squares.
Duckling (#840) (a bright yellow)	½ yard	Second border 2" and piano key border	Cut (3) WOF 2 ½" strips; join strips, then sub-cut into: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (2) 56 ½" x 2 ½" border strips. Cut (2) WOF 1 ½" border strips; sub-cut into: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (2) 38 ½" X 2 ½" border strips. Cut (5) 6 ½" X 2" pieces.
Pimento (#865) (a vivid red)	½ yard	Third border 1" and piano key border	Cut (3) WOF 1 ½" border strips; join strips, then sub-cut into: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (2) 58 ½" x 1 ½" border strips. (2) 42 ½" X 1 ½" border strips. Cut (4) 6 ½" X 2" pieces
Candy Green (#1061) (a turquoise)	1 yard	Piano key border	Cut (4) WOF 6 ½" strips; then sub-cut into: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (80) 6 ½" X 2" pieces

BORDER CONSTRUCTION INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS FIRST. (Unlike me who messed up my first attempt.)**
- If you created each of the five **Sea You in Nova Scotia pattern units**; the assembled quilt will measure 50½" tall x 36½" wide, once all units (1 - 5) are joined.
- Stitch using a ¼" seam allowance ♥.
- First border** (1" finished): Stitch into place left & right pieces; then, top & bottom pieces.
- Second border** (2" finished): Stitch into place left & right pieces; then, top & bottom pieces.
- Third border:** (1" finished): Stitch into place left & right pieces; then, top & bottom pieces.
- PLEASE NOTE:** Each corner block measures 6½" square. All horizontal piano keys are 6½" high; and all vertical piano keys are 6½" wide. To make everything fit; the remaining piano keys are cut at 2" X 6½". ♥ *You may need to slightly adjust the layout for the piano key border by stitching your piano key seams with a generous ¼". When creating this pattern with the EQ8 program it adjusted some of the finished pieces to measure between 1.34" - 1½" (Frustrating as it was to me, in true Maud Lewis style, please keep in mind that your piece will be "wholly your own".* ♥
- ~Piece each section of the piano key borders as shown on page 3.
- Attach piano key sets to the third border; Left & Right, then Top & Bottom as shown on page 3.
- The completed quilt with this optional piano key border will measure 70½" tall x 56½" wide.
- Top stitch as desired.

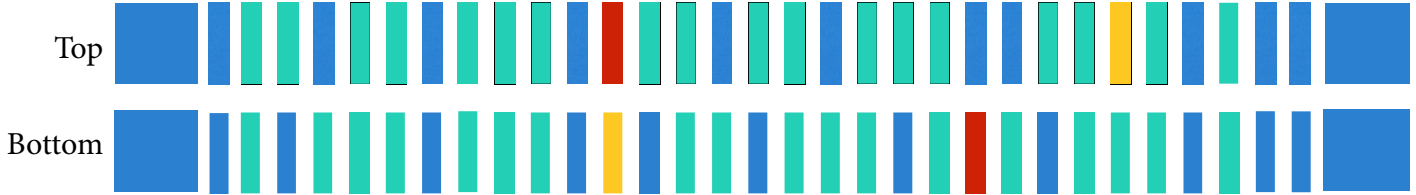

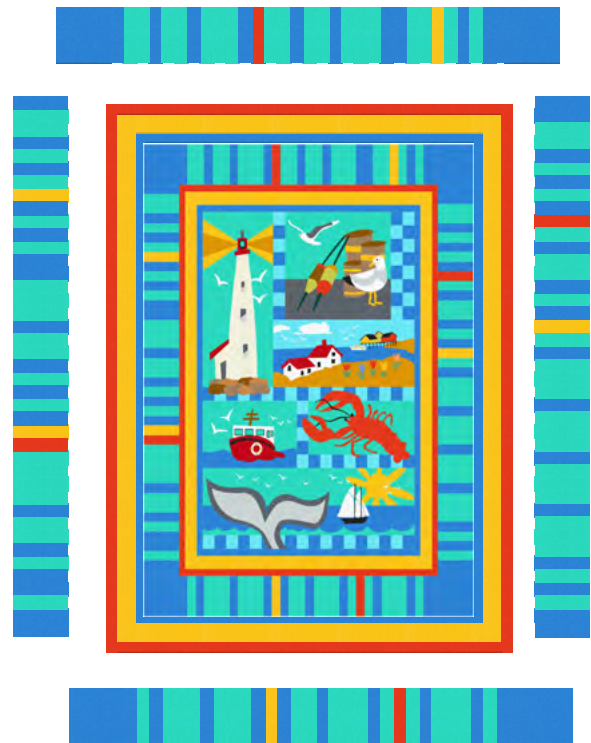
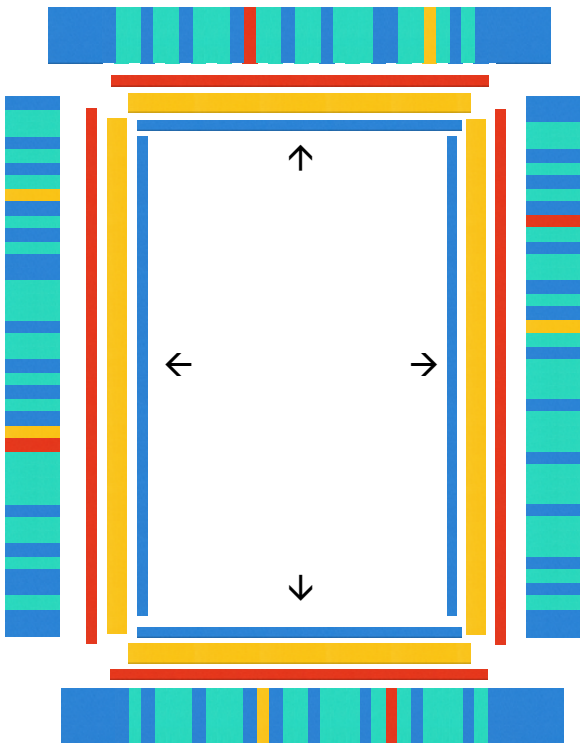
Outer Border: Top/Bottom

NOTE: When finished the first border measures 1" wide; the second border measures 2" wide; the third border measures 1" wide and the outer border is 6".
