Supplies:

- shared iron
- sewing machine

Student Supplies:

- Fabrics:
 - 5 meters of background fabrics
 - 14 to 21 fat quarters of accent fabrics
- 21 – 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" squares of Fusible Web (double-sided interfacing (something like HeatnBond light, Steam A seam 2, Wonder Under or something similar)).
- 2 meters of stabilizer (HEATNBOND Stitch n Sew Tear-Away Stabilizer (or similar to what is used for machine embroidery)).
- Sewing threads and threads to compliment accent fabrics
- Pins
- Seam ripper (in case)
- Scissors
- 6" x 12" ruler
- Square ruler 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" (if you plan to cut your squares in class)

- 6 1/2" X 24" ruler (optional, if you plan to cut long strip in class)
- Rotary cutter
- Truecut 360 degree circle cutter (preferred) or an OLFA - Rotary Circle Cutter
- Cutting mat
- Pencil or other fabric marking tool
- Pencil or pen to write with
- Paper for notes
- And any other supplies that one likes to use while at the workshop.

Square Peg – Round Hole cutting instructions

From the accent fabrics you'll need to cut the following:

- (28) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" (21 of which will be used for 10" circles)
- (14) 5" x 10 1/2" rectangles
- (28) 5" x 5" squares

You'll also need (21) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" squares of fusible interfacing

From the background fabric you'll need to cut the following (read 2nd note):

- (28) 1 1/2" X 5" strips, block strips
- (35) 10 1/2" X 10 1/2" squares
- (7) 1 1/2" X 76 1/2" strips, horizontal lattice strips* (or 14 WOF 1 1/2" strips)
- (2) 1 1/2" X 79" strips, horizontal lattice strips* (optional outer border)
- (2) 1 1/2" X 87 1/2" strips, side strips* (optional outer border)
- (88) 1 1/2" X 10 1/2" strips, vertical lattice and block strips*

*When cutting long strips, I cut the strips 1" to 2" longer than needed, just in case.

** For the workshop have at least 10 of the
10 1/2" x 10 1/2" squares cut.

If requested, I'll demonstrate how to cut
long strips during the workshop.

If you wish to cut the long strips after the
demonstration, bring an 80" long piece
section from the 5 meter background
fabric.
