33. Cut [4] $9^{1}/_{2}$ B strips from **Bag** 1 as follows:

1	[1] 9 ¹ / ₂ "x27 ¹ / ₂ " rectangle [1] 9 ¹ / ₂ " square
2	[1] 9 ¹ / ₂ "x27 ¹ / ₂ " rectangle [1] 9 ¹ / ₂ " square
3	[1] 9 ¹ / ₂ "x18 ¹ / ₂ " rectangle [2] 9 ¹ / ₂ " squares
4	[1] 9 ¹ / ₂ "x18 ¹ / ₂ " rectangle [2] 9 ¹ / ₂ " squares

Quilt Center:


34. Layout all blocks in Step 20 from **Bag** 11, Step 28 from **Bag** 14, Step 29 from **Bag** 15 and Step 30 from **Bag** 16 plus Step 33 **B** rectangles and squares as shown in Quilt Assembly diagram. Sew units in rows together. Press. Sew rows together. Press. Must be 45¹/₂"x63¹/₂".


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Borders:

35. Layout and sew together [4] Step 31 units from **Bag** 17 and [3] Step 31 units from **Bag** 18 as shown. Do not press seams yet. Must be $3^1/2^n \times 63^1/2^n$. Make 2. Sew [1] border to each side of quilt center nesting the unpressed seams to the quilt center seams. Now press seams between blocks. Press border to quilt center.



36. Layout and sew together [2] Step 31 units from **Bag** 17 and [3] Step 31 units from **Bag** 18 as shown. Do not press seams yet. Must be $3^{1}/_{2}$ "x45 $^{1}/_{2}$ ". Make 2.



37. Sew [1] Step 19 3¹/₂" **B** square from **Bag** 10 to each end of Step 36 units. Press to **B** square. Must be 3¹/₂"x51¹/₂". Sew [1] border to top and [1] border to bottom of quilt center nesting the unpressed seams to the quilt center seams. Now press seams between blocks. Press border to quilt center.



- 38. Sew [2] $3^{1}/_{2}$ B strips together end to end. Make 4 for borders.
- 39. Measure quilt top in the middle from top to bottom, raw edge to raw edge. Cut [2] Step 38 border strips this length and sew one border to each side of quilt top.
- 40. Measure quilt top in the middle from side to side, raw edge to raw edge. Cut [2] Step 38 border strips this width and sew one border to the top and one border to the bottom of quilt top.

Layer, Quilt, Bind, Label

- 41. Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
- 42. Cut the following **Binding** fabric as follows:

Fabric	Cut
Binding	[8] strips of your preferred binding width of 2 ¹ / ₂ " or 2 ¹ / ₄ "

- 43. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold this strip lengthwise in half wrong sides together. Press. Stitch to front of quilt matching raw edges and mitering the corners. Press to binding.
- 44. Fold binding over raw edge to guilt back, covering seam. Stitch folded edge to guilt back.
- 45. Create label with name of quilt, your name, location, who for and date. Stitch to quilt back. ∞
