This is a mystery quilt designed in honour of Quilt Canada being held in Manitoba in June 2026.

Quilters will be able to create each release and set it aside to consider it as one element of a larger quilt, or create a series of mini quilts. Think wall hangings, table centrepieces, or hang them as a group.

### Supply List

- Sewing machine cleaned and ready to go
- New sewing needles for your machine
- Rotary cutter with new or healthy blade
- Ruler(s) to help keep cutting lines straight
- Neutral thread colours for piecing
- Iron & ironing board or ironing mat
- Fabric scissors
- Paper/utility scissors
- Pins/clips
- Parchment paper
- Double sided adhesive interfacing such as Steam a Seam 2 or Heat N Bond
- Spray bottle with starch, water, or Flatter Spray by Soak
- Optional:
  - Appliqué scissors
  - Fabric glue, and/or glue pen
  - Water soluble or dissolving or friction fabric marking pens
  - 8 ½ x 11 inch printer or scrapbook paper for working with some patterns
  - Light table with cutting mat
  - Spray adhesive

### Fabric Notes

Each block release will include its own fabric list and since they are all different I can't give them to you right now 😊

Plan for fat quarter friendly pieces, and start reviewing your stash, or arrange to swap with your quilty friends. Plan for pieces with outdoorsy colours (blues, yellows, greens) and neutrals (black, tan, browns, white, off-white, grey).

Overall, the quilt will be approximately 40 x 54 inches (2160 sq inches). To allow for cutting, matching, and seam allowances, that means you will need approximately 3 to 3 ½ yards of fabric in total. This will vary depending on the fabrics you select.

Batting required in total for this quilt, including sufficient allowance during quilting and finishing, is approximately 48 x 62 inches.

Backing fabric for the entire quilt should be approximately 51 x 65 inches.
