

Supply List for Quilt Canada 2026 Workshop

- Workshop Title: 2-for-1: Acrylic Skins and Transfer Artist Paper (TAP)
- Date & Time: Friday, June 19 2026, 8:30 am – 4 pm, 90-minute break for lunch

- Kit Fee: Required - \$50 (cash in an envelope with your name, correct change is appreciated.)
- Required Kit Includes:
- Transfer Artist paper printed with images, Matte Medium and Pouring Medium, Designs for acrylic skins, Crayola crayons to use in class, organza
- CQA/ACC Supplies:
- Shared Iron
- Student Supplies:
- A washed and ironed piece of white fabric (especially if you will be washing the final product. Do not use fabric softener or dryer sheets prior to transferring the image)
 - 6-8 pieces of colourful fabric prepared with fusible interfacing such as Wonder Under - rectangles, strips, squares, etc.
 - Parchment paper or a Teflon sheet
 - A few brush markers or regular markers in colours of your choice
 - A piece of batting - 6" x 6"
 - Any other fabrics you'd like to try the TAP on
 - Tulip Slick – black and/or colours of your choice
 - Tulip Slick™ has rebranded as Tulip Puff - a dimensional fabric paint in easy to squeeze bottles. They are available in 4 fl.oz. (118 ml) and 1.25 fl.oz. (37 ml). It comes in different colours and metallics. Matte, metallic and shiny will work. Do NOT purchase Puffy
 - Another brand that's available is Scribbles.
 - Usually found at Michael's.
 - Clear vinyl sheet protectors
 - No need to purchase expensive or heavy duty ones. I purchase mine at the dollar store (they will be reused).

- A few photocopies of images you'd like to work with: it can be a building, a flower, a bird, text, etc. – black and white or colour works (inkjet or laser). They can be printed as draft – to be used to create your skins
- Painter's tape or masking tape
- Paper scissors
- A few paper towels
- Plastic to cover the table with
- A binder to keep your acrylic skins in once dry (optional) - not needed for class
