- Orbital quilt pattern PDF or paper (required)

- Sewing machine
 - Shared Iron
- Student Supplies: Fabric
- Ugly fabrics that you don't mind sacrificing for science: 2 fat quarters or equivalent in large scraps
 - See pattern for detailed yardage requirements for your desired size of Orbital quilt (see note on next page)
- Printouts
- Orbital quilt pattern instructions
 - Orbital templates for your size of project, taped together & rough cut
 - Completed coloring sheet
 - Orbital quilt labels sheet (optional)
- Notions
- Rotary cutter with a fresh blade
 - Cutting mat
 - Quilting ruler, minimum 6½" square
 - 50 or 80 weight thread
 - Seam ripper
 - Chalk pencil

- Pins
- Washable glue stick

Optional but very helpful:

- 28mm rotary cutter
- Stiletto
- Seam guide or 1/4" presser foot
- Pattern weights (small rulers, books, large coins, etc)
- Spray starch

A note about fabric for the workshop:

During the **experimental portion** of the workshop, you will use your ugly fabrics to try out different techniques for sewing curves. These fabrics should be the same quality quilting cotton that you use for most of your quilt tops – cheap fabrics may behave differently and give you misleading results.

For the **project portion** of the workshop, you will be making the upper-right quadrant of your Orbital quilt (Wedge 1 and Wedge 2 in the pattern).

1. Decide which **size** quilt you're making. (All sizes are the same level of difficulty.)
2. Plan your layout and fabric choices using the coloring sheet in the pattern or online at geekybobbins.com/coloring and bring it to the workshop.
3. If you are traveling and you don't have space in your suitcase for all the yardage needed for your quilt top, these are the **minimum fabrics to bring to the workshop:**
