- Optional Kit Includes:
- Hardware only: 4 1" Rectangular Rings; 2 1" Triangle Rings (Matte Black will have D-rings instead); 2 1" Designer Swivel Snap Hooks; 1 1" Adjustable Strap Slider; 1 4-1/2" or 7-1/2" Wallet Closure
- CQA/ACC Supplies:
- Domestic Sewing Machine – Bernina
 - Shared Iron
- Student Supplies:
- Howie Bowler Bag pattern (purchased at UhOhCreations.com or paper copy from your favorite quilt shop)
 - Completed pre-work (details will be provided 3 weeks prior to class via email) for the following items (please bring excess to class for accidental miscuts): Exterior cotton fabric, Exterior accent cotton fabric, Lining cotton fabric, Fusible woven interfacing (44" wide), Foam stabilizer, Fusible fleece, Heavy stabilizer
 - 1 - #5 Purse Zipper - with two pulls
 - 1 - #3 Zippers - with one pull
 - 1" (2.5 cm) wide Webbing
 - New Microtex or jean needles for your machine (90/14 or 100/16) as well as a backup
 - Thread to coordinate with your fabrics (polyester is recommended, although cotton is ok – 40 wt or Tex 35 or lighter)
 - Pins or Wonderclips (or binder clips)
 - Chop stick, or tool for pushing out seams
 - Seam Ripper
 - Fabric Scissors

- Temporary marking tool – frixion pen or chalk, etc. – ensure it works on your exterior fabric
- Ruler (approximately 6" x 12" or larger is recommended)
- Glue Stick (can be a standard school grade glue stick or a fabric glue stick) (Optional)
- Lighter (Optional)
- 1/8" wide Double-sided Tape or Wash-Away WonderTape (Optional)
- 1" wide Painter's Tape or Masking Tape (Optional)
