CQA/ACC Supplies:

- Sewing Machine – Husqvarna

- Shared Iron

Student Supplies:

- Rotary cutter

- Cutting mat

- Rulers -one square ruler like 4" or 6 ½" or 9 ½", this ruler should have a diagonal line to with the Triangle square up. A second ruler that you like to cut yardage with 6"x 24" or a 6" by 12" can work if you're willing to fold fabric 4 times. If you get all your precutting done, then only a triangle ruler is needed.

- Seam ripper

- Fine pins

- pin cushion

- thread snips, thread to sew by machine

- More pins (safety or not) for your design wall flannel,

- Pen, pencil, I will have a handout and graph paper. Coloured crayons/pencils to design on paper. 12 crayons work fine.

- Flannel white or cream(batting works too) to design on, enough pins to hold fabric to move it home. 40" square is as big as we will have room for. We would love to have design walls but at conferences it just can't happen. Some people love a flannel backed tablecloth, you might pin thought it.

- Phone camera a great design tool

- Fabric – This is a class you can be extra scrappy and bring the whole rainbow 6 different colours in many fabrics and 5 step value change in black and white prints. But for that please do the precutting ahead of time, start now. You will not be able to sew that much in one day. So,

less volume of fabric but more different pieces. It will take a long time to cut.

- Fabric with more control and not the whole rainbow, a pretty set of fat Quarters 12 to 24 or layer cake (jelly rolls are not wide enough) can be used. Bring what you feel comfortable using. But the more choices the better. Make sure your fabrics have a contrast, dark, light and medium fabrics. My background was white, grey to black, but you can simplify it with one background fabric, in that case 1 meter of a light or very dark (wall quilt size 30"sq) 2 m or more if you are wanting a bigger quilt and plan to do more after class. All your other fabrics will need to contrast to that single background.
- Precutting fabric before class please! It will save you time! My quilt was made with 3" squares and after sewing the triangles, I re cut and squared up my triangles to 2 ½" squares, finished size 2". If you are a beginner at Triangles and /or want a large quilt you can make your precut size 4" to get 3" finished triangles. How many squares to cut? I say 120 background squares and 120 in your prints or rainbows fabrics. To finish your quilt be prepared to do more cutting and sewing after class.
- Please contact me by email if you have questions. You can send photos of your fabric plan before you cut if you would like. I know your fabric choices are wide open. More advanced quilters might want to play in the rainbow. Go simpler if your unsure. Cathy Tomm email <mailto:cathytomm@gmail.com>
